

Figure S7: Causal genes are significantly enriched in genes involved in tissue-specific PPIs. Each pie chart describes the fraction of genes with tissue-specific PPI numbers ranging from 0 to 5 and above. Notably, 54% of the hereditary disease genes have at least one tissue-specific PPI, relative to only 42% of all interactome genes ($p=8.8 \times 10^{-5}$, Fisher exact test).
