

Supplementary Table 2. Cardioembolic sources of ischemic stroke

Sources of high primary risk of stroke

Left atrial thrombus

Left ventricular thrombus

Atrial fibrillation

Paroxysmal atrial fibrillation

Sick sinus syndrome

Atrial flutter

Recent myocardial infarction (<4 weeks)

Rheumatic mitral or aortic valve disease

Bioprosthetic or mechanical heart valves

Chronic myocardial infarction with ejection fraction < 28%

Congestive heart failure with ejection fraction < 30%

Dilated cardiomyopathy

Nonbacterial thrombotic endocarditis

Infective endocarditis

Papillary fibroelastoma

Left atrial myxoma

Sources of low or uncertain primary risk of stroke

Mitral annulus calcification

Patent foramen ovale

Atrial septal aneurysm

Atrial septal aneurysm and patent foramen ovale

Ventricular aneurysm without thrombus

Isolated left atrial smoke

Complex atheroma in the ascending or proximal arch
