ADR	Dialogue about an ADR patients either believe they are experiencing or has the potential to experience
Clarification	Dialogue requesting or providing additional information about a medication
Indication	Dialogue about the rationale for the medication's use
Dose or rate	Dialogue about the medication dose or rate
Route	Dialogue about the route of the medication
Suggestion	Dialogue that requests suggestions for medication to address a perceived need or symptom
Formulation	Dialogue about the medication's formulation or flavor, including brand/generic substitutions
Contraindication or interaction	Dialogue about the medication's contraindications or interactions with other drugs
Monitoring	Dialogue about the monitoring of medication effectiveness or toxicity
Duplication	Dialogue about either 2 identical medications or 2 medications to treat the same condition
Missing medication	Dialogue about a medication that the patient should be receiving or is expecting to receive but is not
Other	Dialogue about any other medication-related topic

Inform	Response that provides information to address the family's medication-related dialogue
Acknowledgment Change	Response that acknowledges the family's medication-related dialogue
Add medication	Health care team ordered a medication
Stop medication	Health care team discontinued a medication
Scheduling change	Health care team changed the medication's frequency or duration
Dose or rate change	Health care team changed medication's dose or rate
Route change	Health care team changed the medication's route
Formulation change	Health care team changed the medication's formulation or flavor
Defer	Response indicating that additional information is needed before a full response can be made
No response	No response or acknowledgment is made
