



S1 Figure. Western-Blot detecting Gluc fusion proteins in bacterial lysates. Samples were subjected to protein electrophoresis using Bis-Tris gradient gels. A polyclonal anti-Gluc antibody was used to detect SipA¹⁻⁶⁸⁵-C-Gluc₁₀₆ and SipA⁴⁸⁻⁶⁸⁵-C-Gluc₁₀₆. InvB-N-Gluc₁₀₅ could not be detected by this antibody (upper panel). As control DnaK was detected with a monoclonal antibody (lower panel).
