



SUPPLEMENTARY FIG. S2. Chronic perforation with eustachian tube (ET) occlusion. Figure demonstrates the otoscopic view of a chronic perforation created with KB-R7785 and ET occlusion at 3 months. There is copious amounts of mucoid otorrhea (**a**) which obstructs the view of the TM. After gentle wicking of the otorrhea (**b**), the perforation and the thickened reddened TM can be seen.
