

SUPPLEMENTARY FIG. S2. Chronic perforation with eustachian tube (ET) occlusion. Figure demonstrates the otoscopic view of a chronic perforation created with KB-R7785 and ET occlusion at 3 months. There is copious amounts of mucoid otorrhea (a) which obstructs the view of the TM. After gentle wicking of the otorrhea (b), the perforation and the thickened reddened TM can be seen.
