

Supplemental Figure 3: IMQ-induced psoriasis-like plaque

Comparisons of skin samples from mice treated daily with control cream or 5% IMQ Aldara[®] for 5 days. (A) Appearance of psoriasiform lesions on mouse back skin. (B) H&E staining of back skin sections. The following histological changes are present in the IMQ treated mice: Epidermal hyperplasia [Ep], pustule [P], orthokeratotic hyperheratosis [arrow], parakeratotic hyperkeratosis [arrow head] and inflammation [I]. (C) Accumulation of Ly6B.2⁺ neutrophils in mouse skin detected by immunohistochemistry. (D) Representative density plot showing cell surface markers
