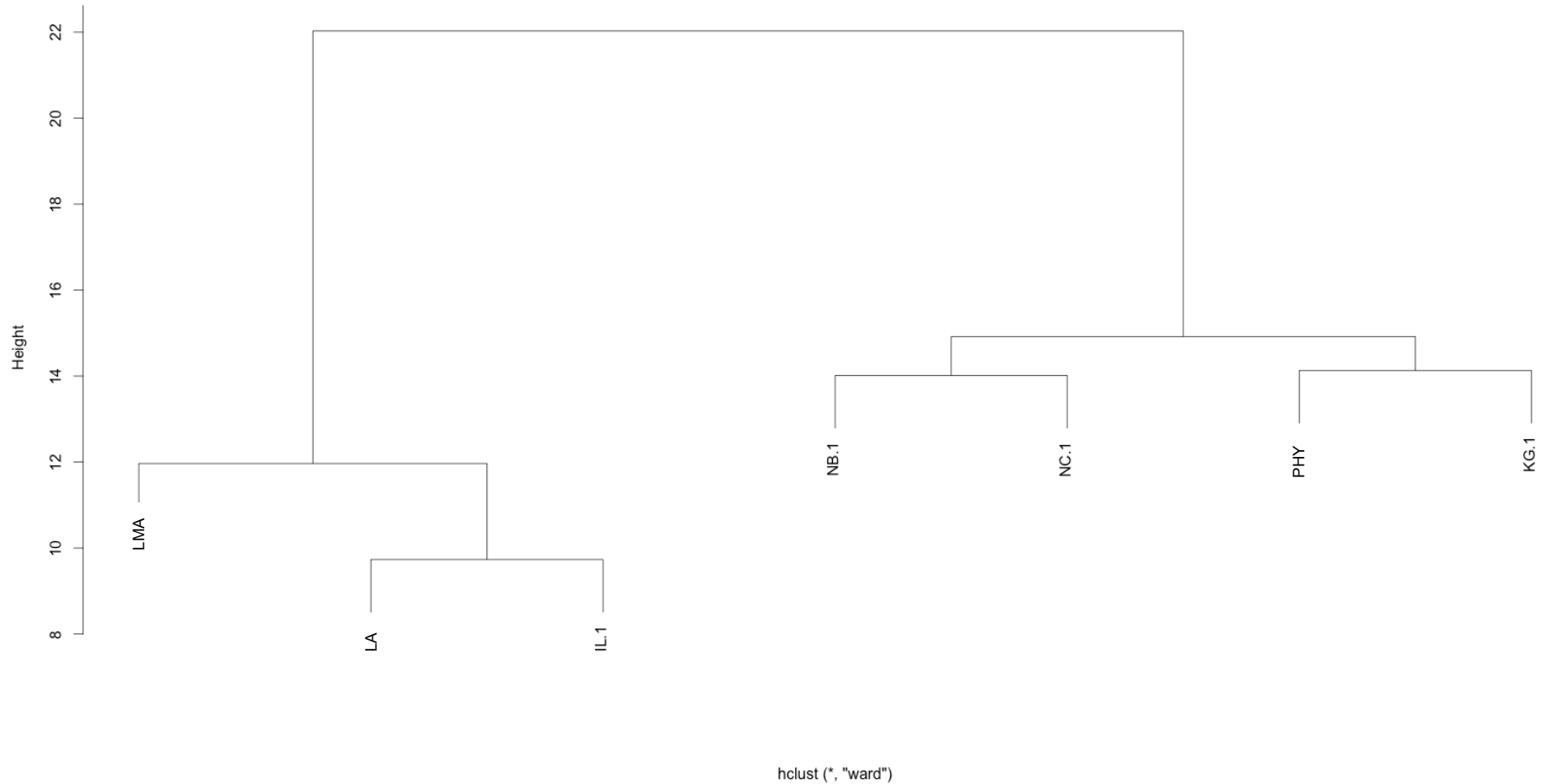


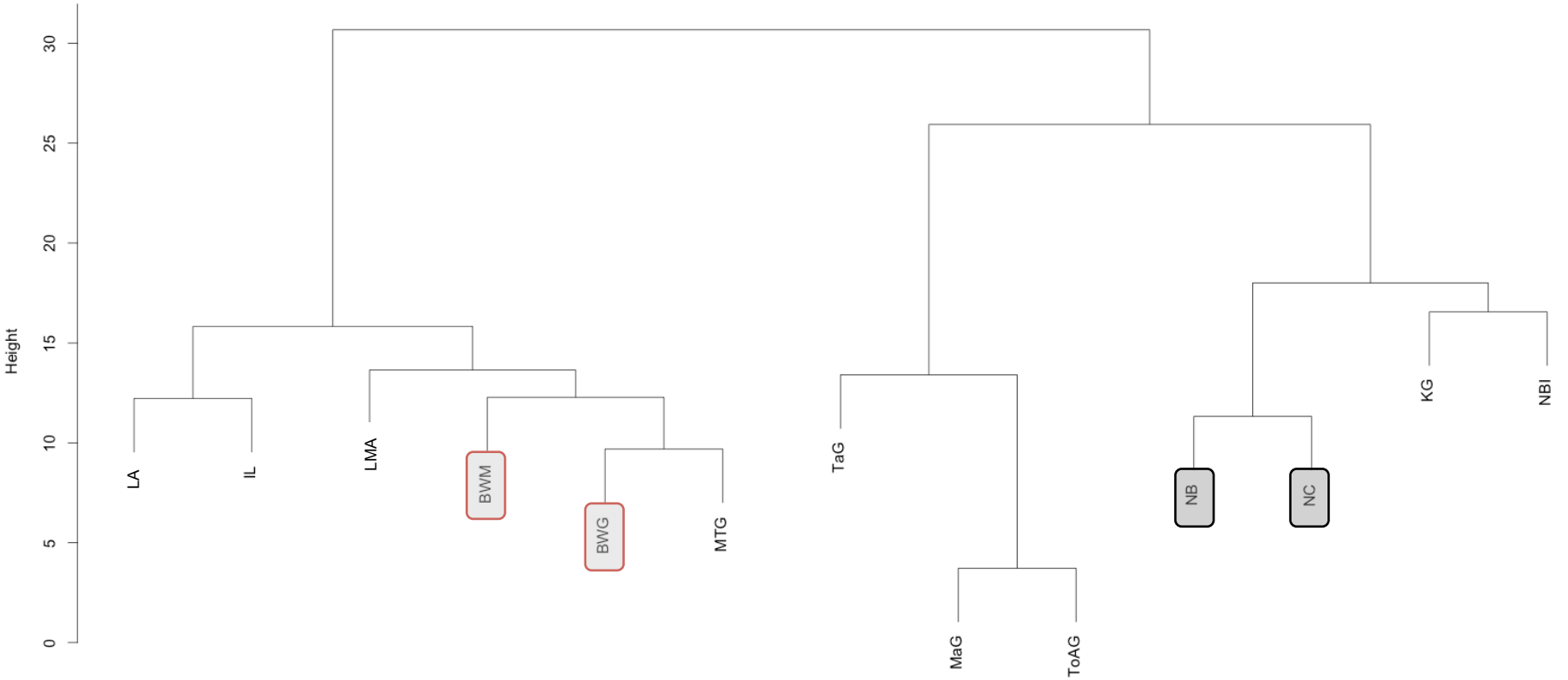
Figure S2. Hierarchical classification of 43 traits under each growing condition.

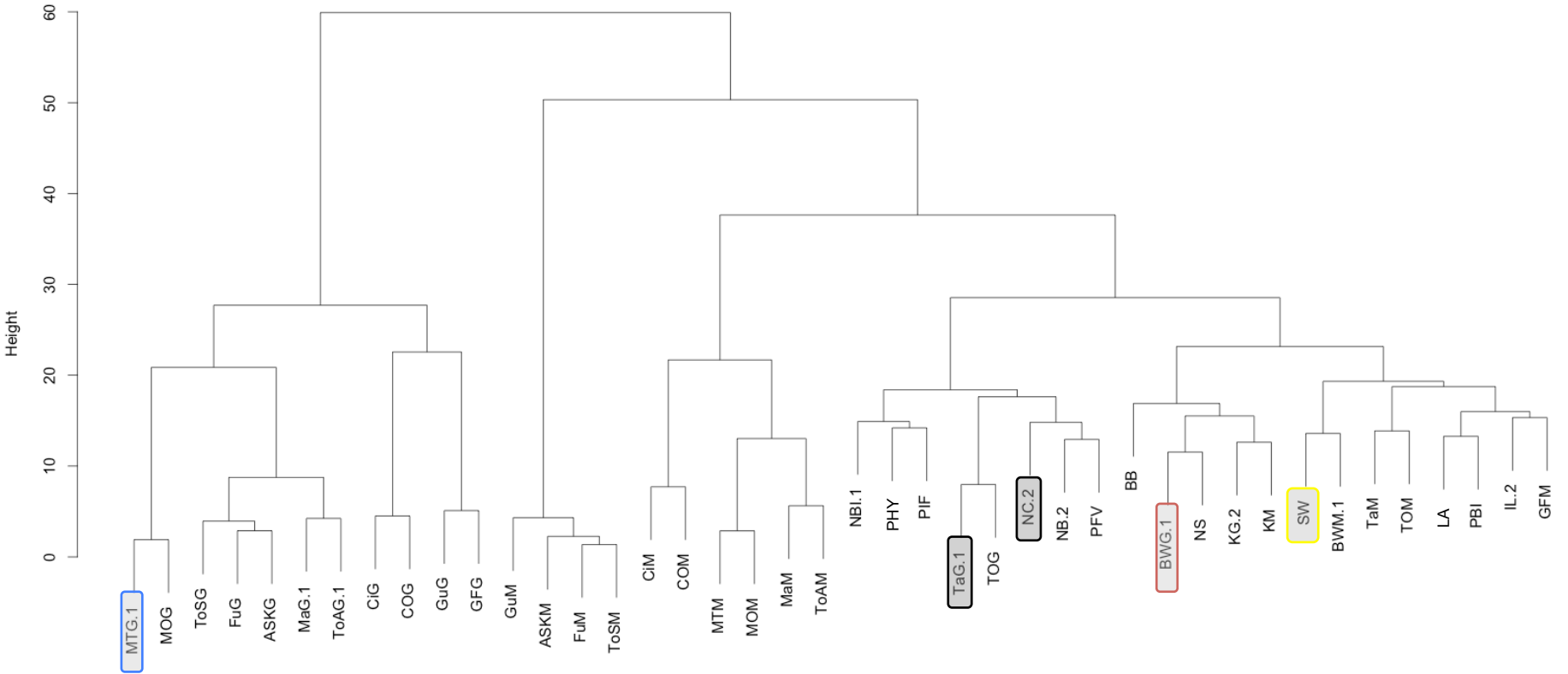


Hierarchical classification of 2011 outdoors traits



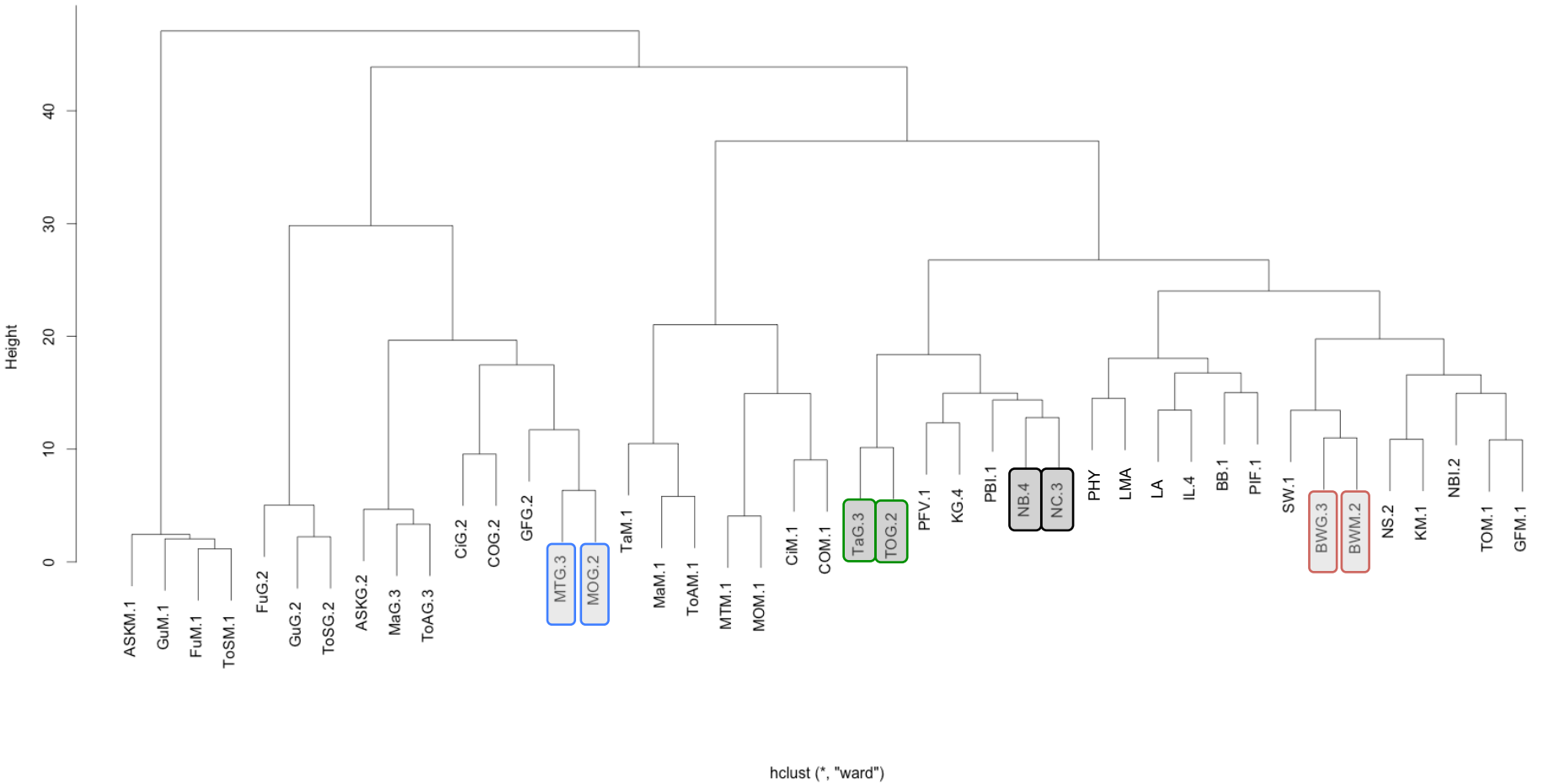

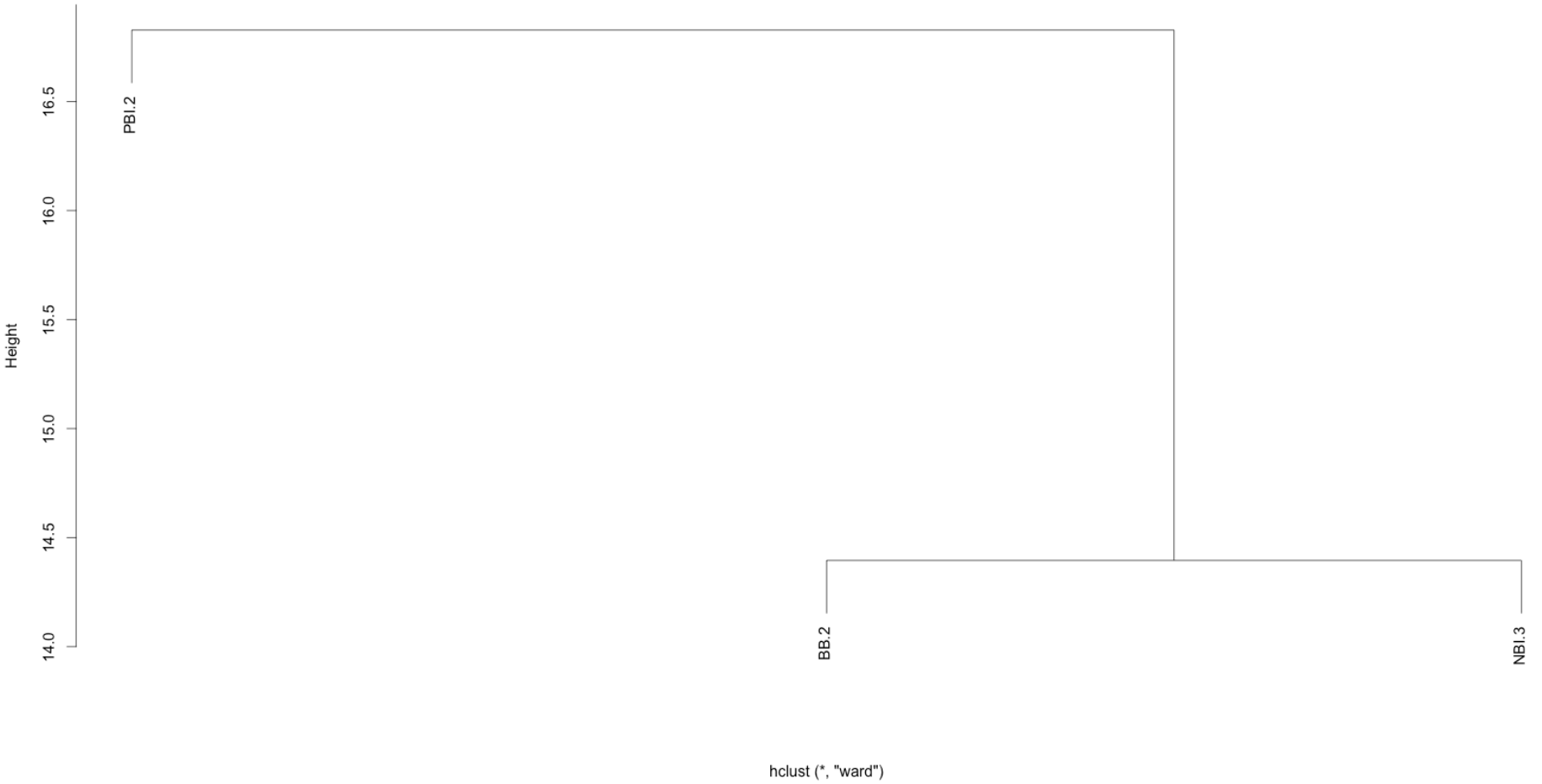

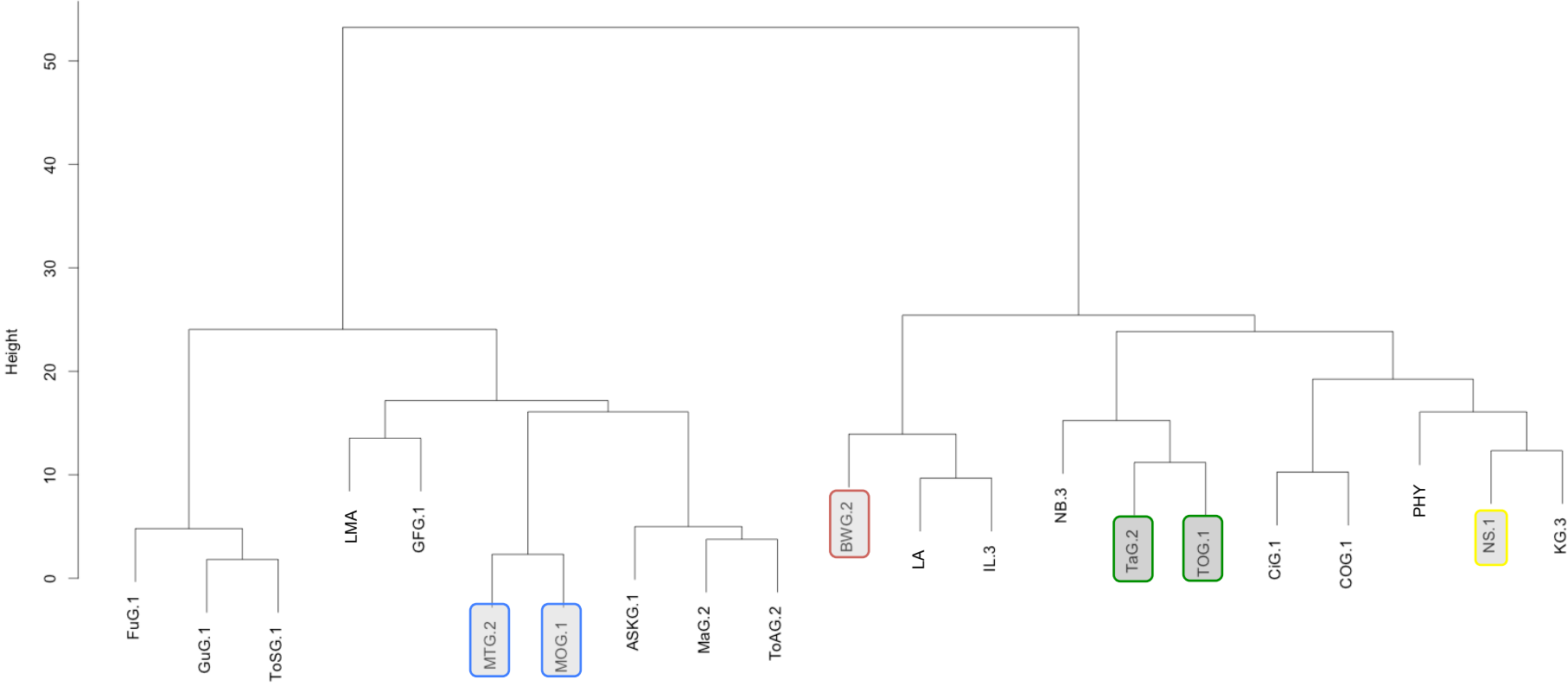

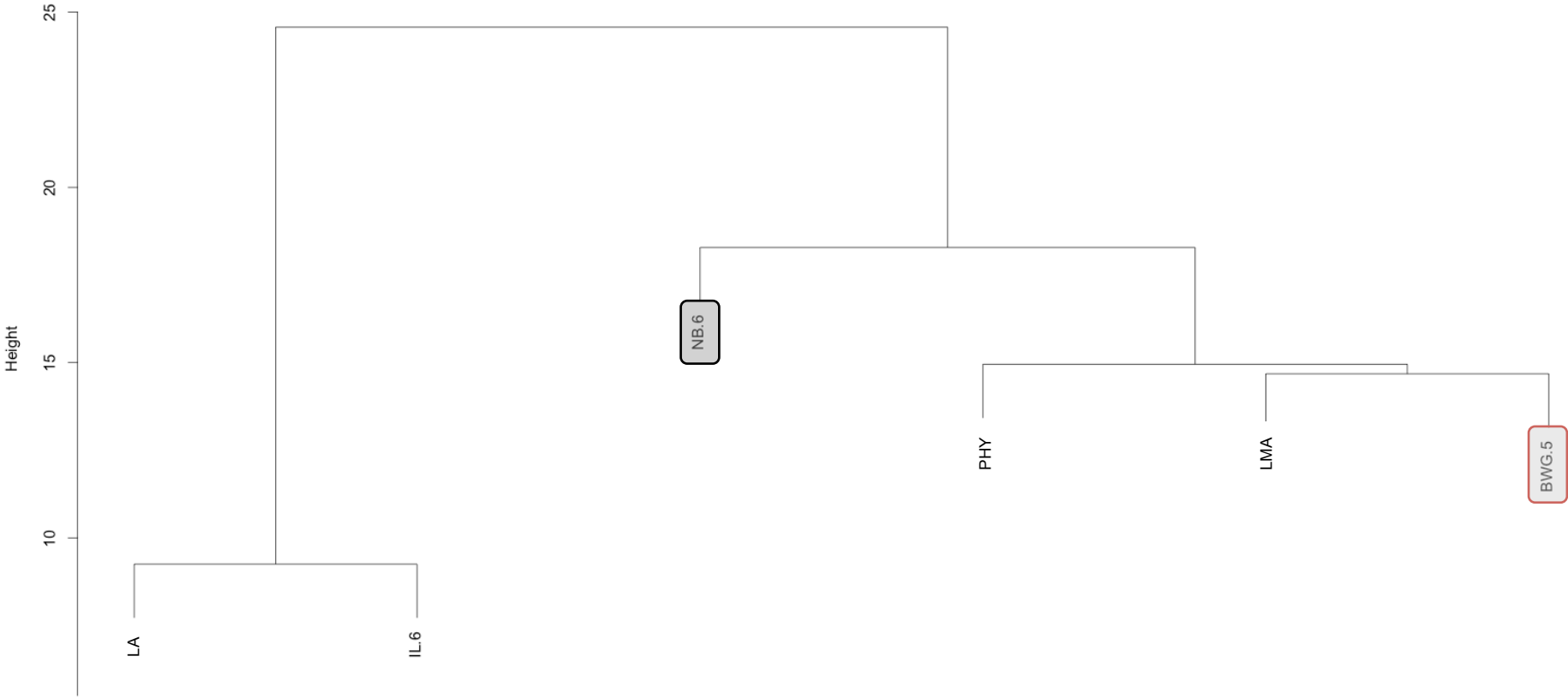

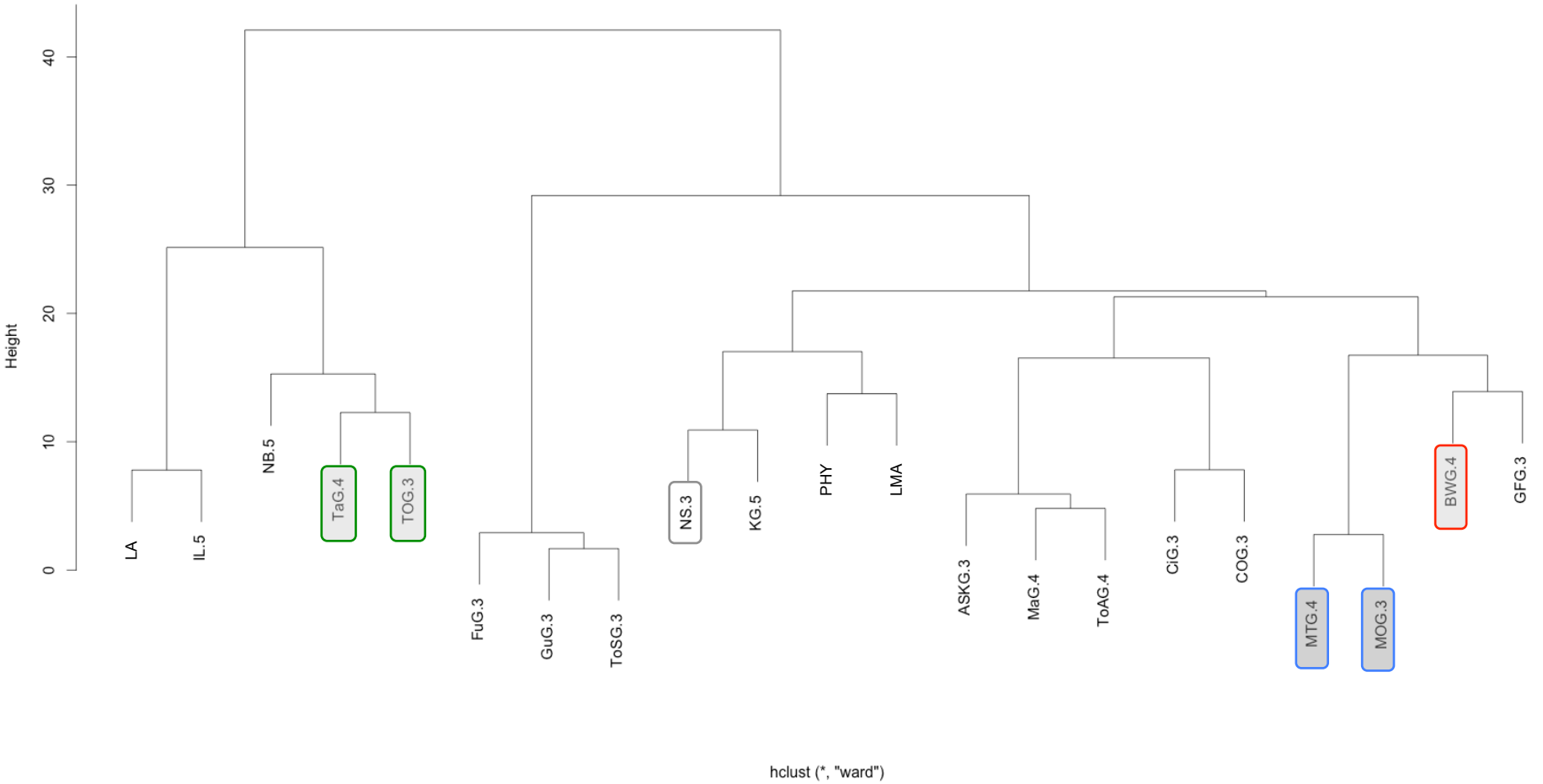
