

**Figure S1**. Phenotypes apparent in aged Barx2 null mice on the outcrossed and inbred (C57BI/6) backgrounds. By 15-18 months of age, Barx2-/- mice display hunched backs, splayed-limb stance, disheveled coats and mild alopecia. The phenotypes are typically worse on the C57BI/6 background (bottom panel). Wildtype and heterozygous mice do not show these signs of musculoskeletal aging until at least 24 months.
