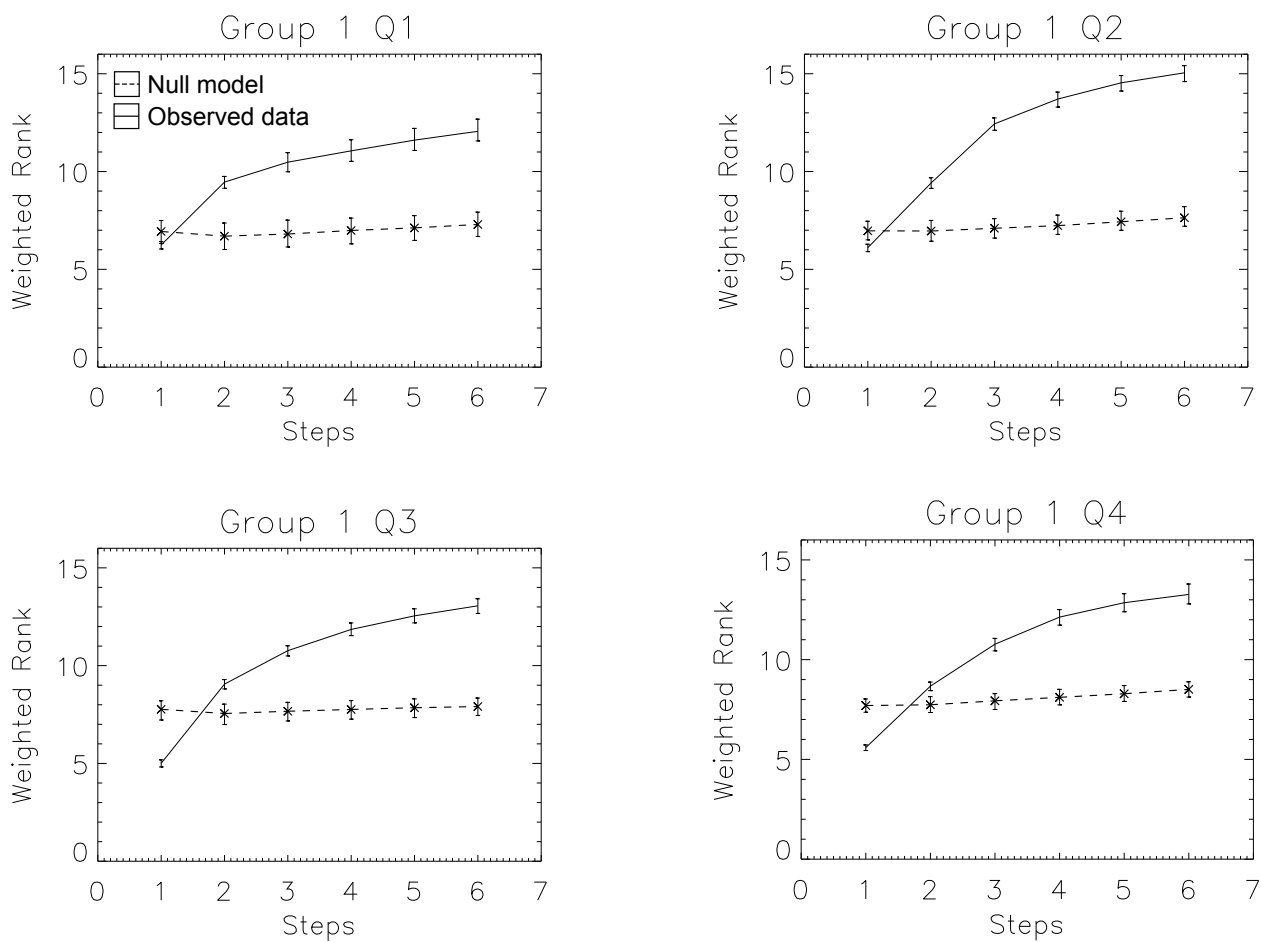

Transitive signals of rank already appear in Quarter One, where the one- and two-step aggression chains can clearly distinguish relative ranks. In Quarters Two, Three and Four, these signals strengthen, so that three- and even four-step aggression chains now contain additional information.
