Table S2. The innate immune response is not activated in pupae 4 hours after irradiating late third instar larvae. Late third instar larvae were irradiated at the indicated doses and mRNA levels for six different AMPs were quantified in whole pupae 4-4.5 hours after irradiation. Wild-type Canton-S male and female larvae were used for these experiments. Values are given as mean expression of each AMP RNA (2-4 trials each) normalized to mean expression of the corresponding RNA in non-irradiated, age-matched controls (fold induction) ± SEM. Rp49 was used as the reference gene. See Table S1 for primers used.
