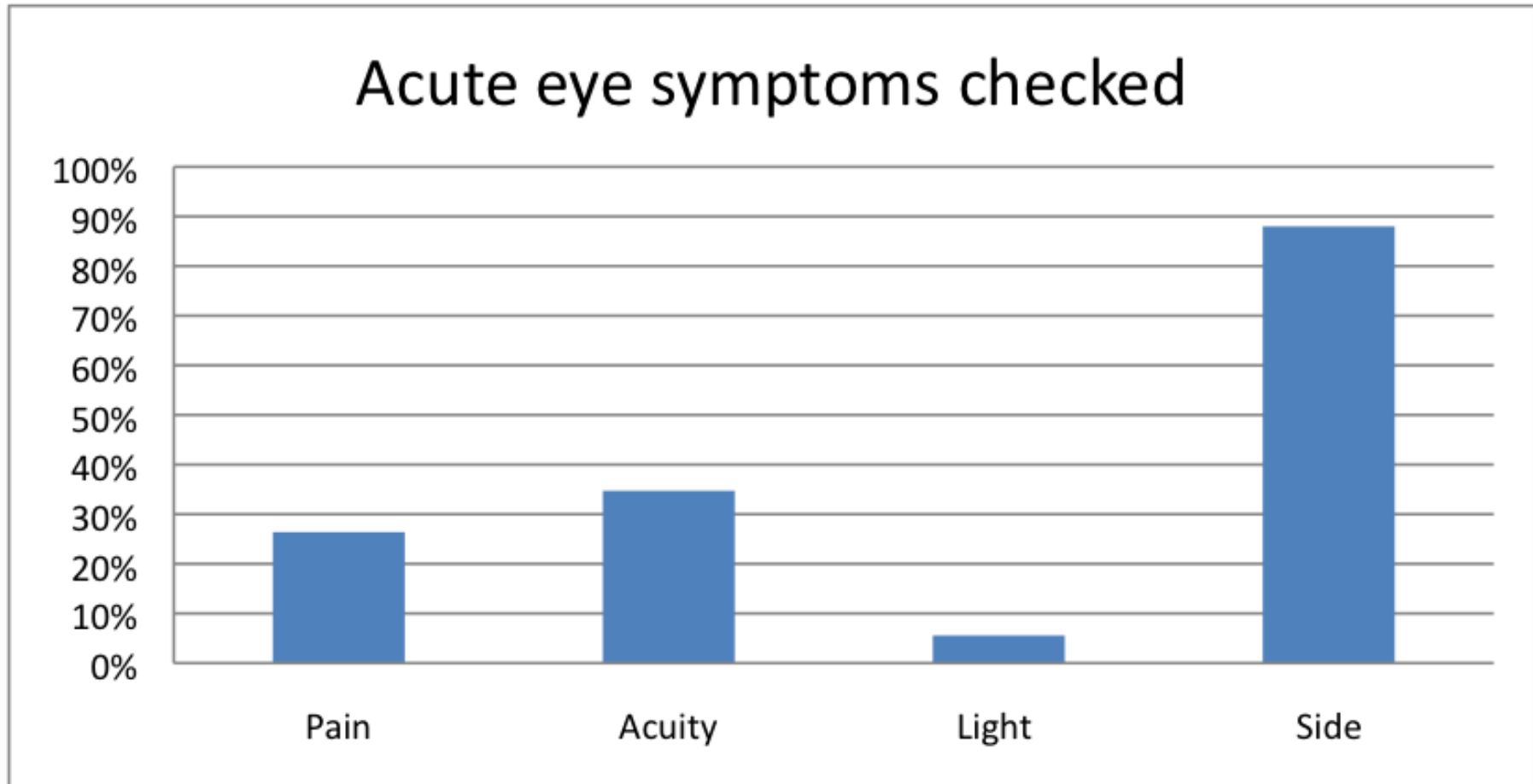

## Cycle 1 vs Cycle 2 results

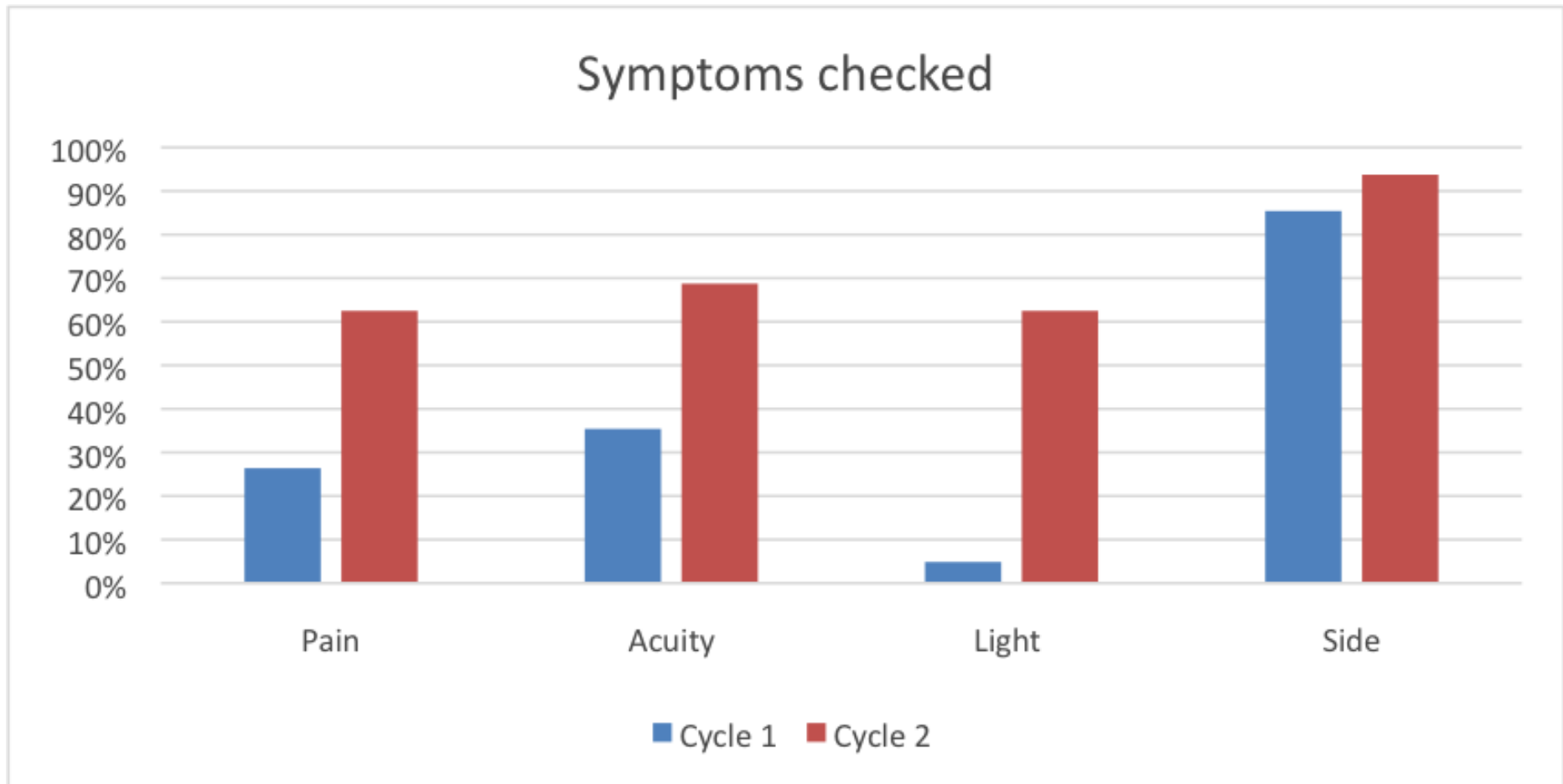

**over two audit**

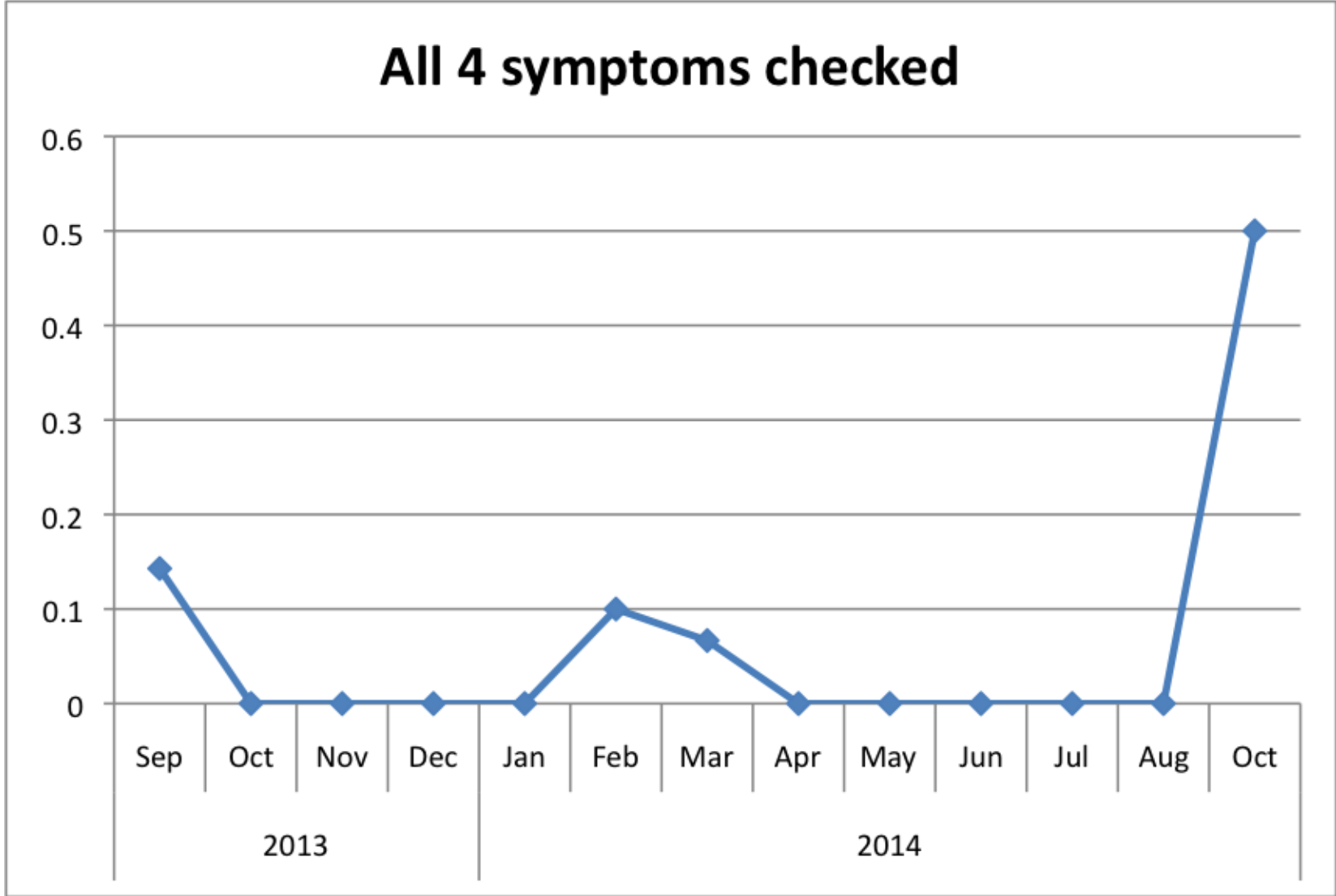

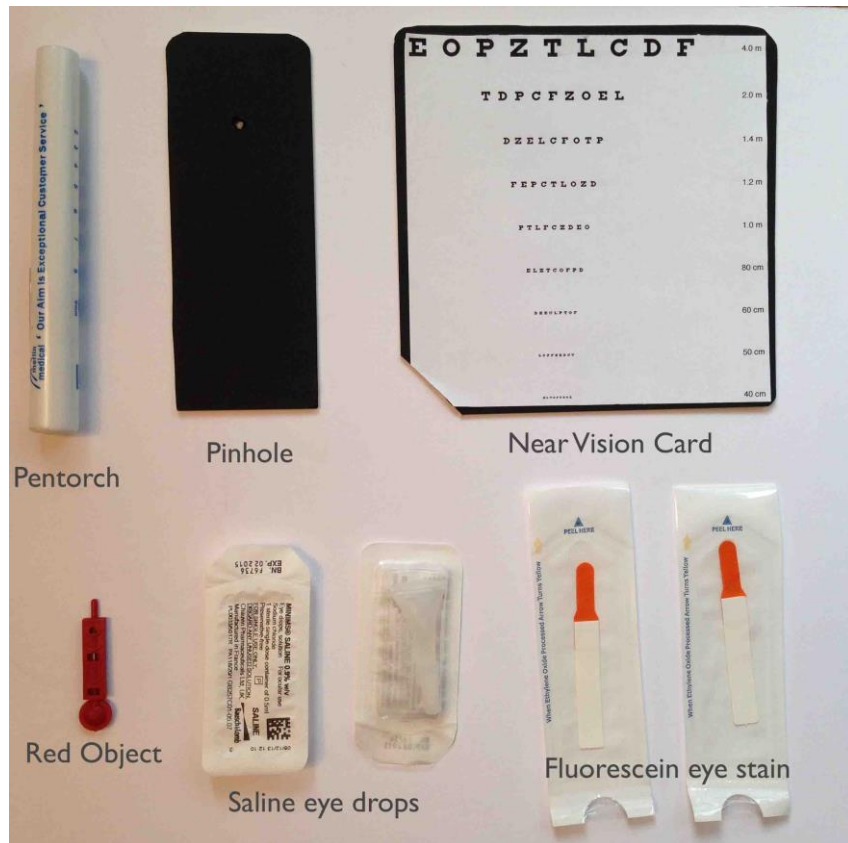

## Acute Red Eye / Ophthalmology consultations

P.A.L.S Symptoms screen: Does your patient have any of these symptoms?

**Pain**  
**Acuity**  
**Light**  
**Side (Unilateral/Bilateral)**

Pain in eye  


Impaired vision  

Light hurts eyes  

If any of these symptoms are present, consider the six sight-threatening conditions:

1. Acute glaucoma
2. Corneal Abrasion/ Keratitis
3. Iritis
4. Scleritis
5. Penetrating eye injury or embedded foreign body (may not always cause red eye)
6. Acid or alkali burns

If symptoms present, **consider referral for same-day assessment by Ophthalmology.**  
Conjunctivitis should not present with symptoms above.

Wears contact lenses  

\*Contact lens wearers are more at risk of pseudomonal eye infections, which can be sight-threatening and require quinolone antibiotics. Discuss with Ophthalmology if concerned.

Fluorescein Staining

Pupils

- Anisocoria - unequal pupil diameter (Xa8...)
- O/E - Argyll Robertson pupils (2BG3.)
- O/E - fixed, dilated pupils (22E4.)
- O/E - pinpoint pupils (22E3.)
- O/E - pupils irregular (2BG2.)
- O/E - pupils react to accommod (2BI5.)
- O/E - pupils react to light (2BI3.)
