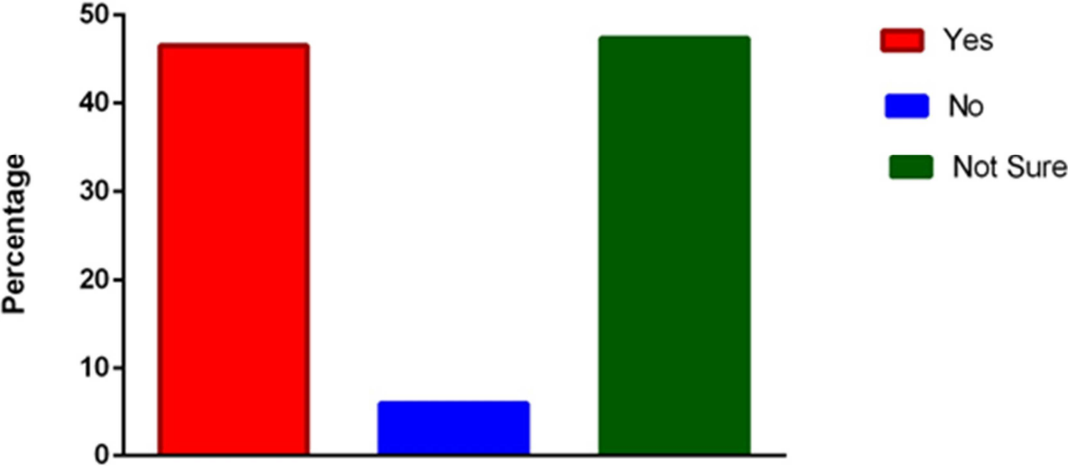

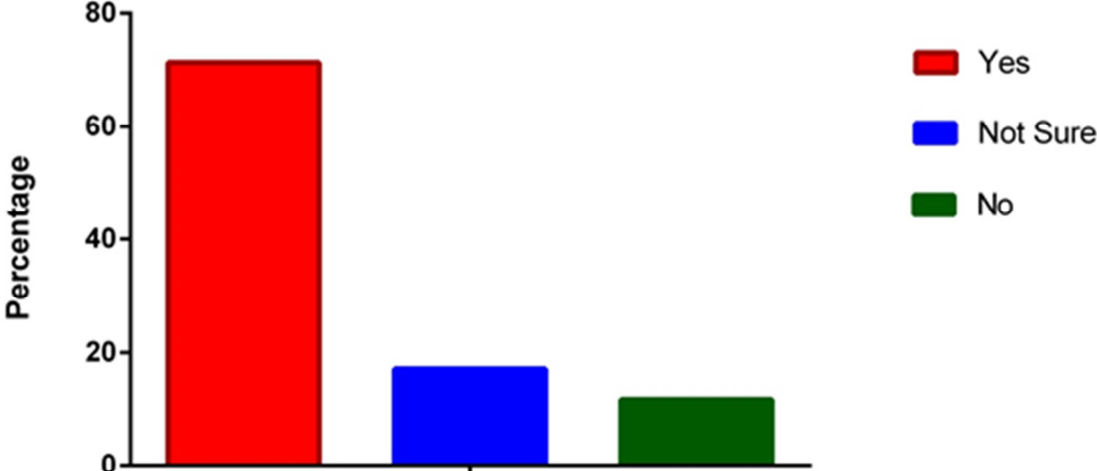
Supplemental Table 1: Questions Included in the Survey

Survey Questions

5	Do you think there is a need for better evidence-based online tools to help you engage your adult patients in shared decisions about cholesterol treatment?
6	If there were a good evidence-based online tool to help you engage in shared decision about cholesterol treatment with adult patients, how likely would you be to use it regularly in practice?
7	Is there anything else you would like to tell us about the new cholesterol guidelines for adult patients, the use of online risk calculators in your practice, or what would help you best in the clinical treatment of cholesterol?
