Why carry out this study?

- Finasteride is one of the most common drugs used in androgenetic alopecia.
- The literature discusses the sexual side effects, however in practice we don't see much.
- The aim of the present study was to investigate the sexual dysfunction in patients taking finasteride 1mg for androgenetic alopecia using a questionnaire given to approximately 586 male Indian patients.

What was learned from the study?

 Analysis showed no significant difference in sex related problems with that of patients taking finasteride and age matched controls, suggesting that sex related issues are not a side effect of finasteride.

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
