Why carry out this study?

- Treatment non-adherence is a complex problem encountered in all therapy areas, particularly in chronic diseases such as psoriasis vulgaris
- Topical therapies may be perceived as messy, inconvenient and time consuming, posing an additional challenge to adherence
- To improve patient experience with fixed combination Cal/BD topical suspension, we developed an applicator delivery system that caters to some unmet needs of psoriasis patients

What was learned from the study?

- The Applicator delivers a consistently accurate dose, allows for targeted and precise application to body and scalp psoriasis plaques, and offers a 'no touch' option for patients
- For some patients with psoriasis vulgaris, the Applicator has potential to provide greater control over daily psoriasis management, which could promote long-term treatment adherence

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
