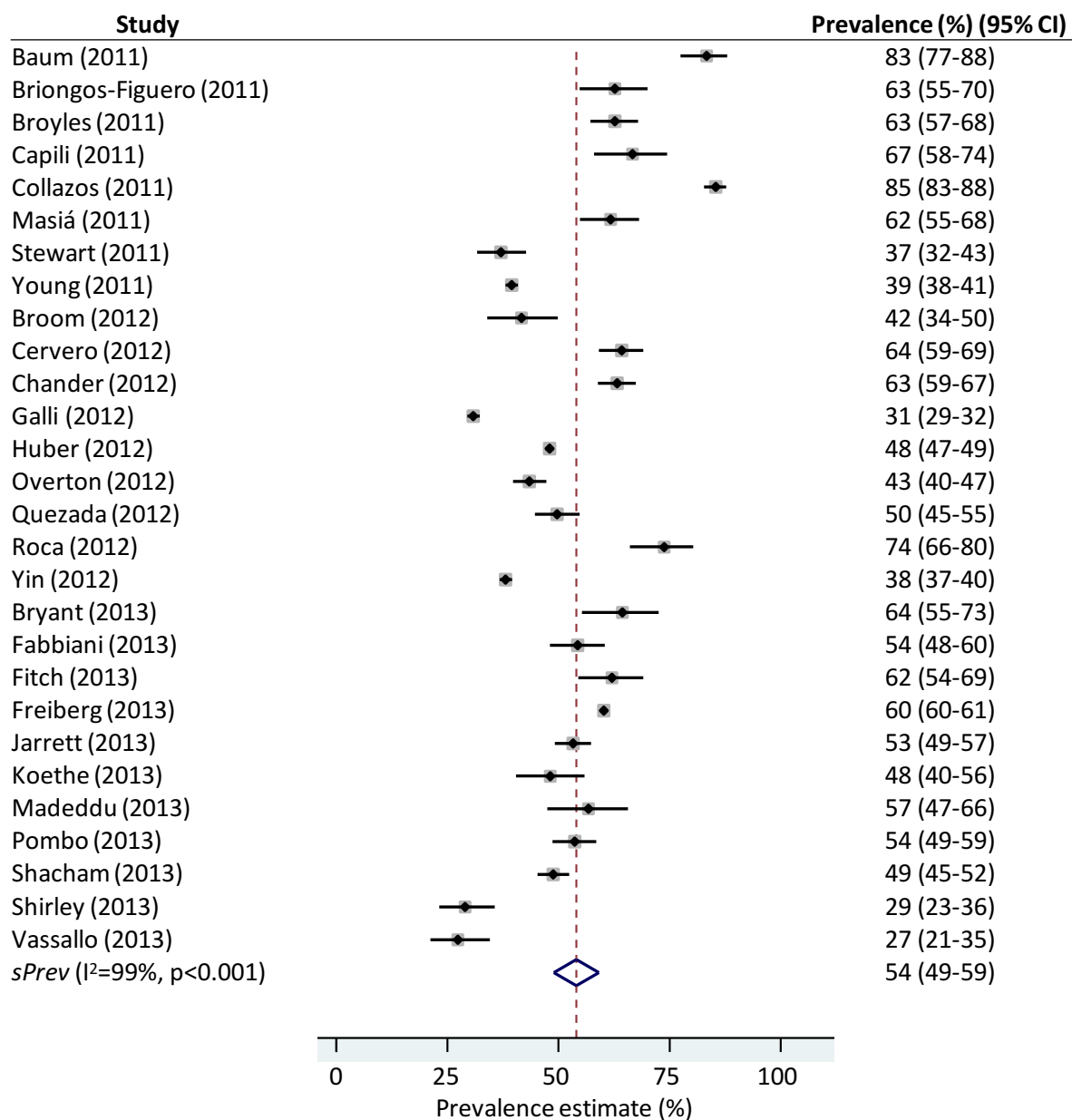
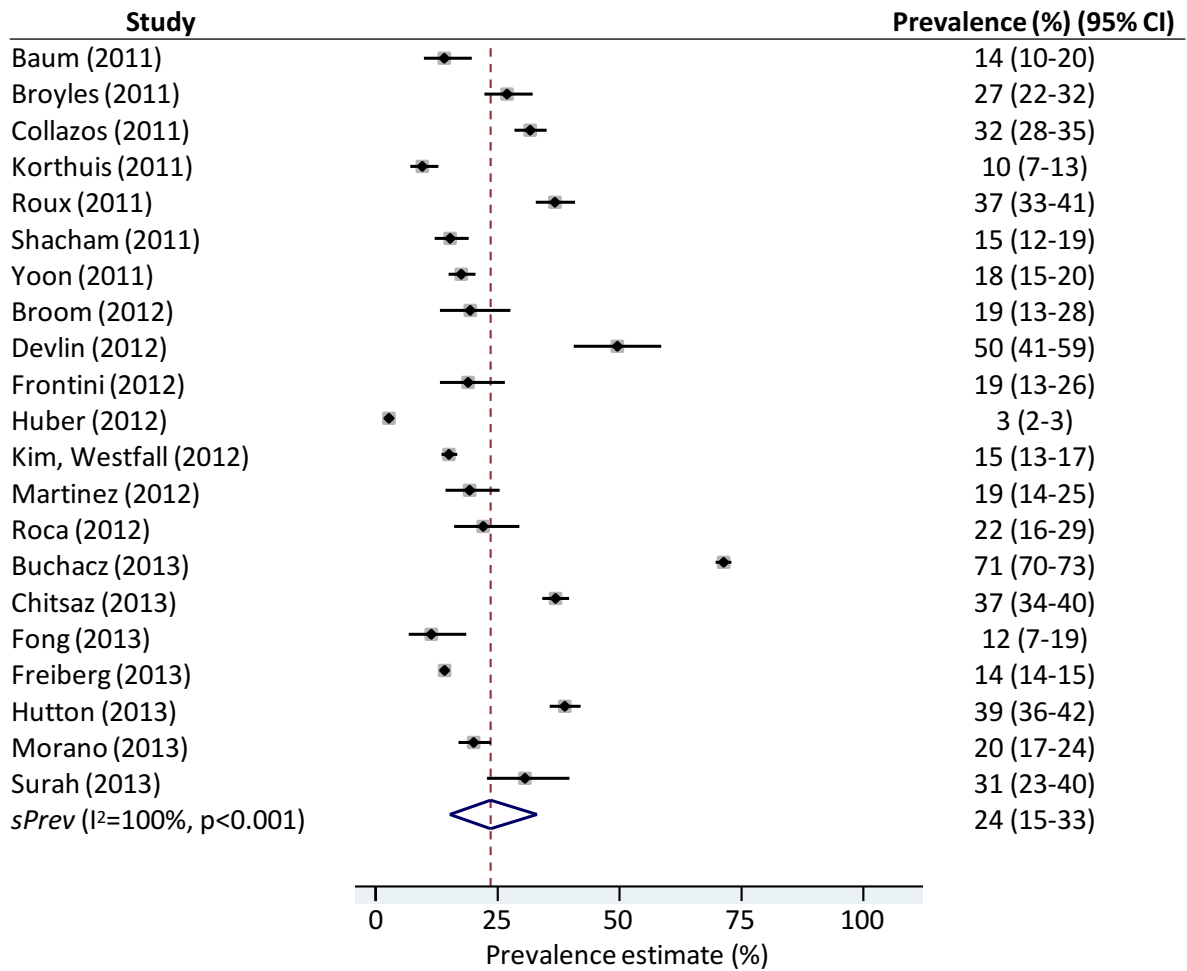

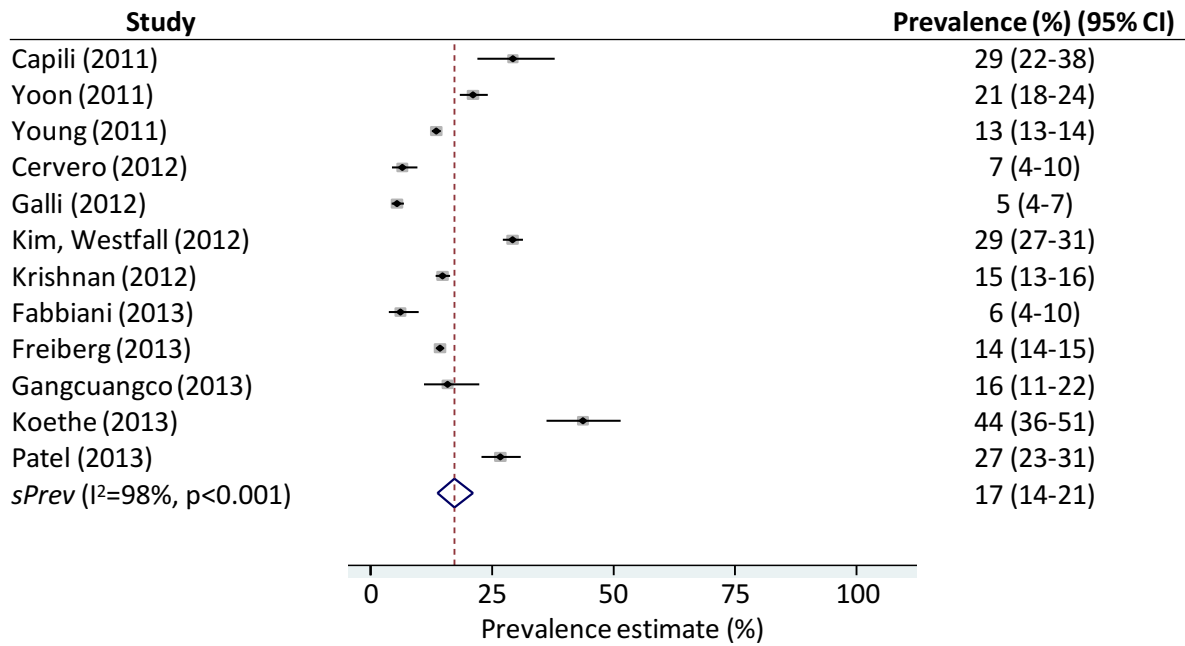
(a) Current smoking prevalence among overall^a



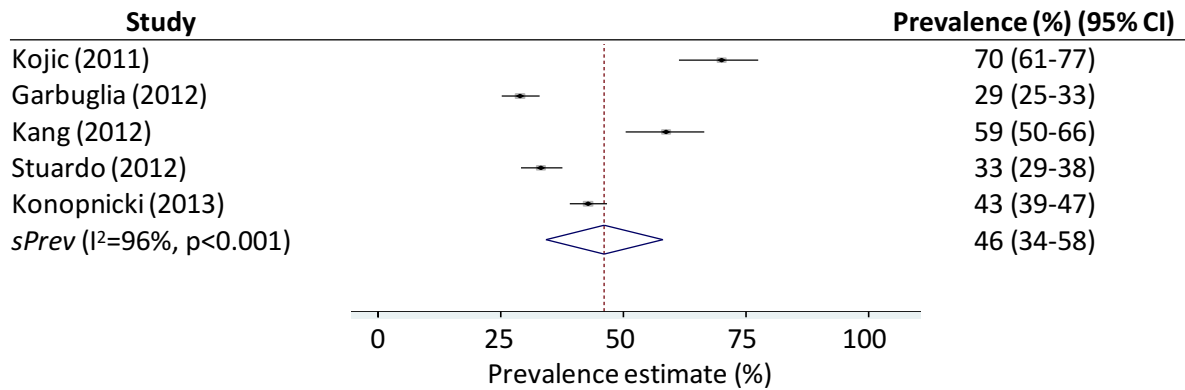
(b) Hazardous alcohol consumption prevalence among overall^a



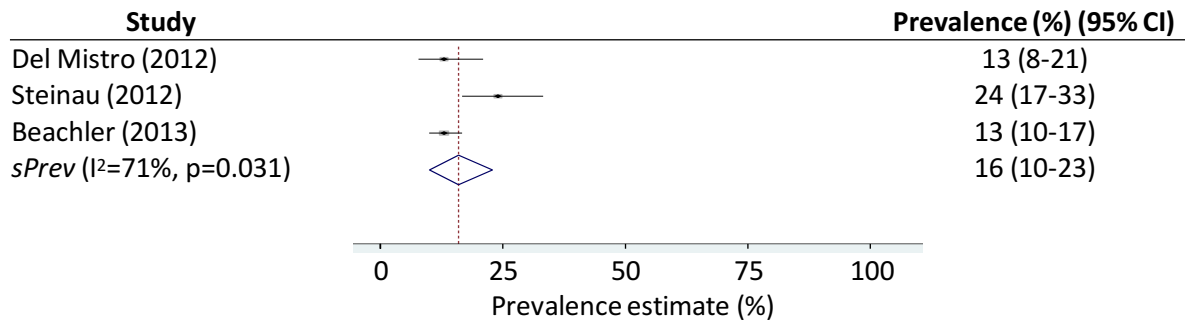
(c) Obesity prevalence among overall^a



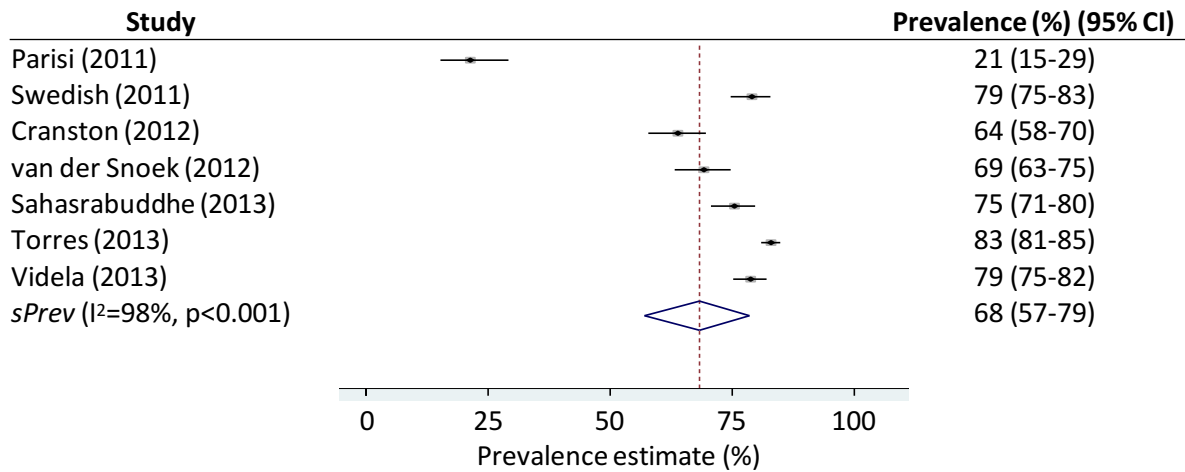
(d) Cervical high-risk human papillomavirus infection prevalence



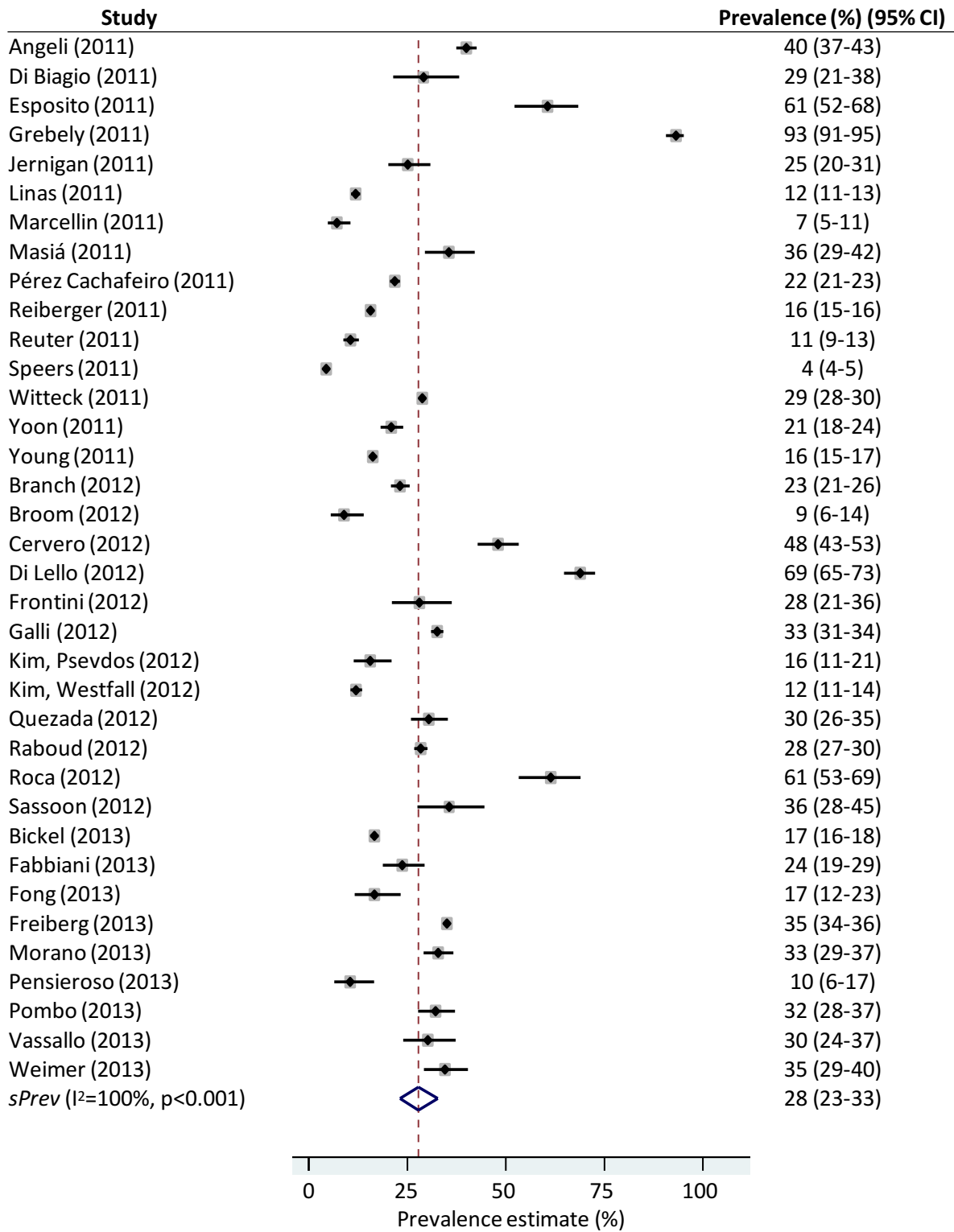
(e) Oral high-risk human papillomavirus infection prevalence among overall^a



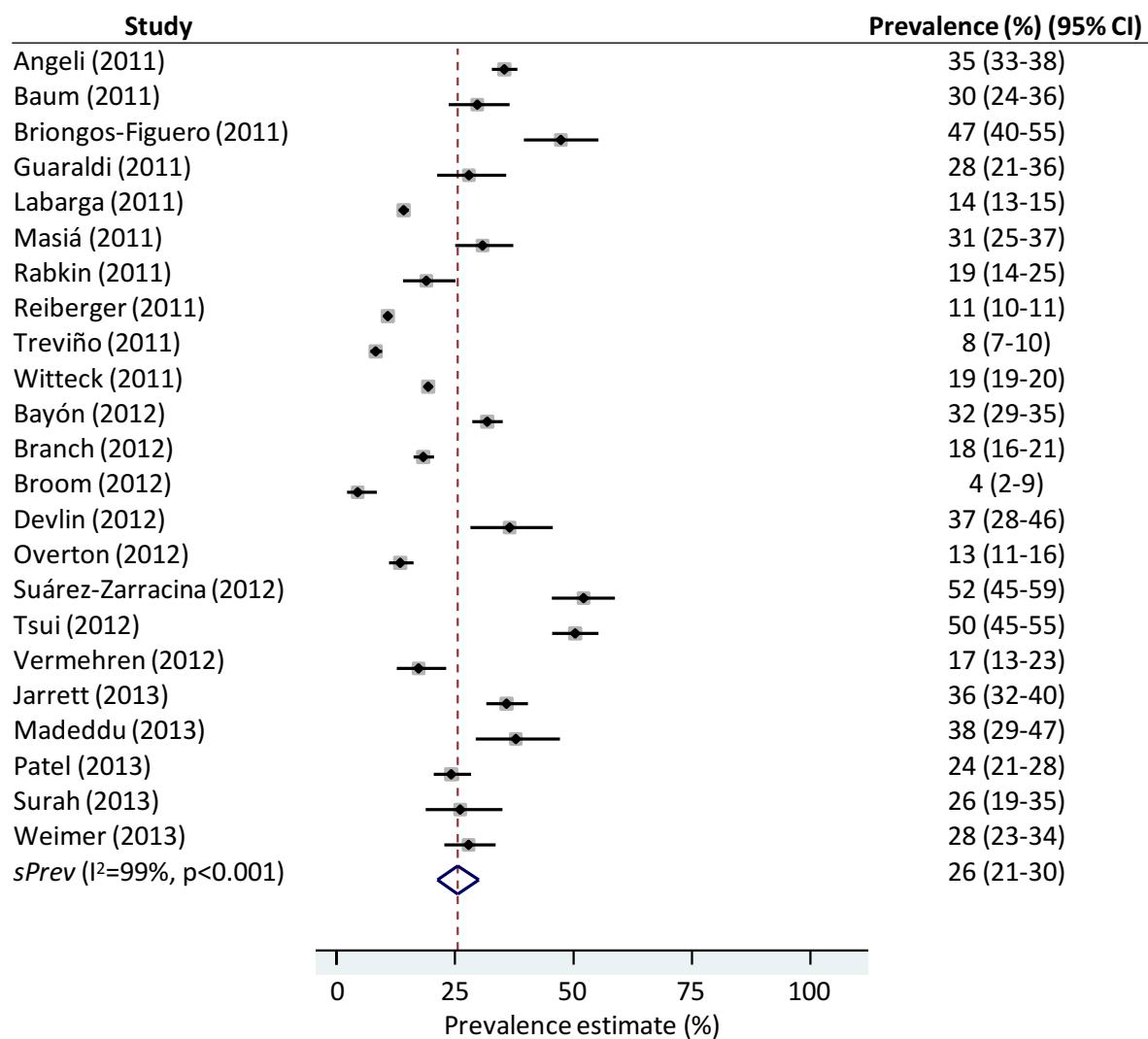
(f) Anal high-risk human papillomavirus infection prevalence among men who have sex with men



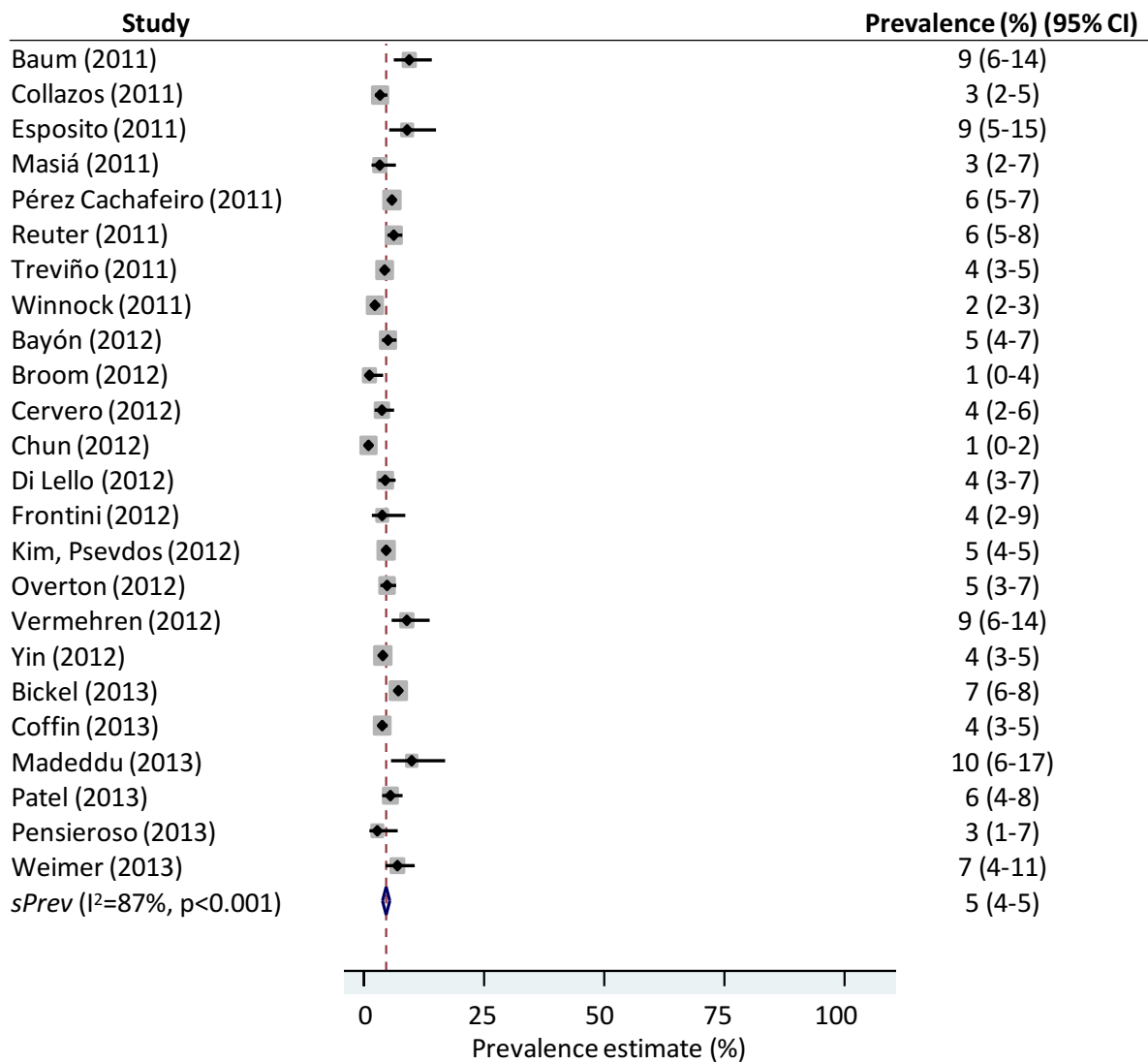
(g) Hepatitis-C-virus-exposed prevalence among overall^a
