



FigS1. Clinical scores for BALB/c (A) and CBA/Ca (B) after pneumococcal infections. Each experimental group is described by the letter that denotes mouse strain: "B" for BALB/c or "C" for CBA/Ca and a number that denotes pneumococcal strain: "71" for BS71, "35" for BHN35, "T4" for TIGR4, "39" for D39, "418" for BHN418, "191" for BHN191, "69" for BS69, "215" for LgtSt215, "100" for BHN100 and "206" for CBR206. Clinical score of 1 denotes normal and of 7 lethargic animal. Score of 7 continue to be assigned to the expired animal until the end of the experiment (168h) (detailed explanation in the Methods section). The error bar represents standard error of the mean (SEM)
