## Appendix A: Procedural Knowledge Checklist

## Central Line Placement (Internal Jugular)

#### Indications:

- 1. Monitor CVP
- 2. Difficult peripheral vascular access in the multi-injured trauma patient
- 3. Delivery of concentrated electrolytes, i.e. potassium
- 4. Total Parenteral Nutrition
- 5. Plasmapheresis or long term antibiotics
- 6. Delivery of agents irritating to peripheral veins, i.e. amiodarone, phenytoin, mannitol
- 7. During cardiopulmonary resuscitation

### Contraindications:

- 1. Local site infection or burn
- 2. Anatomic abnormalities
- 3. Coagulopathy

# Complications:

- 1. Injury to artery
- 2. Arrhythmia
- 3. Air embolism
- 4. Thoracic duct injury (with left internal jugular)
- 5. Pneumothorax or hemothorax
- 6. Infection of cannulation site
- 7. Bleeding/hematoma
- 8. Venous thrombosis, pulmonary emboli
