

Supplementary Fig. 2. Effects of muscarinic acetylcholine and serotonergic receptor antagonists. (a, f) CON refers to non-oxaliplatin treated group. Behavioral tests to measure the cold allodynia were performed before and after the intrathecal injection of muscarinic acetylcholine and serotonergic receptor antagonists in four groups: (b) NS (n=4), (c) pirenzepine (n=9), (d) methoctramine (n=7), and (e) 4-DAMP (n=6). (g) DMSO (n=4), (h) NAN-190 (n=6), (i) ketanserin (n=6), and (j) MDL-72222 (n=6). None of the antagonists affected the pain behavior. Data are presented as mean mean±S.E.M.
