

S8 Fig. Images of circulating blood cells at representative time points after wasp infection. (A-A"") Uninfected Me/w-larvae, larvae of the same genotype infected by (B-B"") L. boulardi, (C-C"") L. clavipes, or (D-D"") L. heterotoma. In uninfected larvae, plasmatocytes were the predominant blood cell type at all times. In L. boulardi- and L. clavipes-infected larvae, the first lamellocytes were seen in the circulation 18-20 h and 20-22 h after infection. At these time points, the mCherry expression was often very faint in comparison to later time points. L. heterotoma-infected larvae had only very few lamellocytes. Scale bars 50 μ m.
