

SUPPLEMENTARY FIG. S2. Definitions of computed variables. (a) Estimated date of infection: the midpoint between the last negative and first positive test in the surveillance. (b) Estimated duration of infection: time between the estimated date of infection and the sample date (months). This is the primary variable for the categorization of infections. (c) Known duration of infection: time between the first positive date and sample date (months). This is a secondary variable for the categorization of infections.
