

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**Fig. S2.** Boxplots of episodic recognition (*d'*) for high and low familiar odors, response bias (c) for high and low familiar odors, episodic recognition (*d'*) for high and low familiar sounds, and response bias (c) for high and low familiar sounds (from left to right), separately for early blind (dark grey boxes), late blind (light grey boxes), and sighted (white boxes) participants. The boxes indicate the 25th, 50th (median), and 75th percentiles of the distribution (lower, middle, and upper horizontal lines of the box). The upper hinges indicate the maximum value of the variable located within a distance of 1.5 times the inter-quartile range above the 75th percentile. The lower hinges indicate the corresponding distance to the 25th percentile value. Circles indicate values outside these hinges (outliers). The means and 95 % confidence intervals (dots and error bars in blue) are superimposed on the boxplots.
