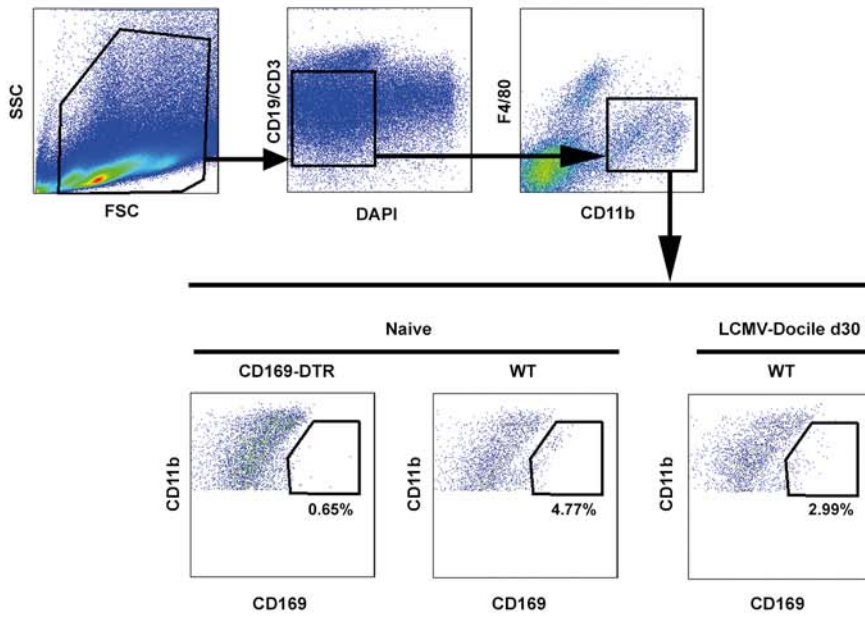

Supporting Information, Figure 1. FACS staining of cells from C57BL/6 WT mice infected with 2×10^4 PFU lymphocytic choriomeningitis virus strain Docile (LCMV-Docile) for 30 days or left uninfected. Naïve CD169-diphtheria toxin receptor (DTR) mice were treated with diphtheria toxin ($30 \mu\text{g}/\text{kg}$) on day -3 and were used as negative controls. Splenocytes were stained with the immunofluorescence antibodies DAPI, CD3, CD19, F4/80, CD11b, and mSiglec-1 (CD169) ($n = 3$).
