1. On what date did you note that your dog began to wag his tail? Do not include movement noted during or immediately after defecation or direct stimulation of the tail. If you are able, describe the circumstances under which you noted movement (i.e. you called his name, he saw someone he knows, etc.).

2. On what date did your dog begin voluntarily urinating a noticeable consistent stream of urine?

3. If you have been manually expressing or catheterizing your dog's bladder, on what date were you able to stop?

4. Have you noticed that your dog's urine has a bad odor, contains blood, or that your dog has an increased frequency of urination or pain on urination in the last 2 weeks?

5. Has your dog suffered from any incontinence (involuntary urine leakage) in the last 2 weeks? If so, when is it occurring?

6. Has your dog had a urinary tract infection diagnosed and treated by your local veterinarian since we last saw you? If yes, what were the culture results and what antibiotics have they been treated with?

7. On what date did you first note that your dog began to move his hind limbs?

8. On what date did you first note that your dog was able to stand unassisted?

9. On what date did you note that your dog began to take steps when supported to stand?

10. On what date did you note that your dog began to take steps when unsupported?
