

Supplemental Figure 1. No significant difference between HwTw, HcTw and bleeding groups

The graph shows the change over time under each condition. A significant blood pressure disparity was not observed in the head cooling group (HcTw) nor the bleeding group (Bleeding) compared to the control group (HwTw) based on two-way ANOVA.
