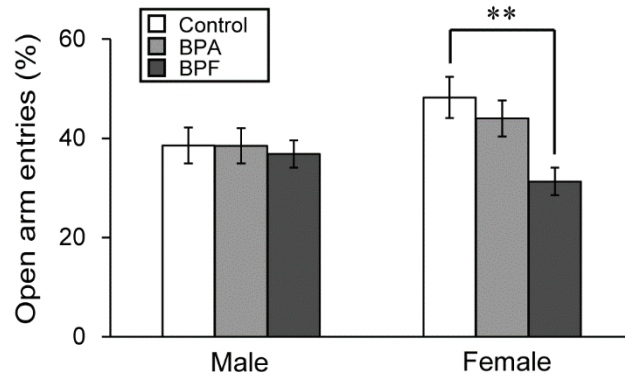


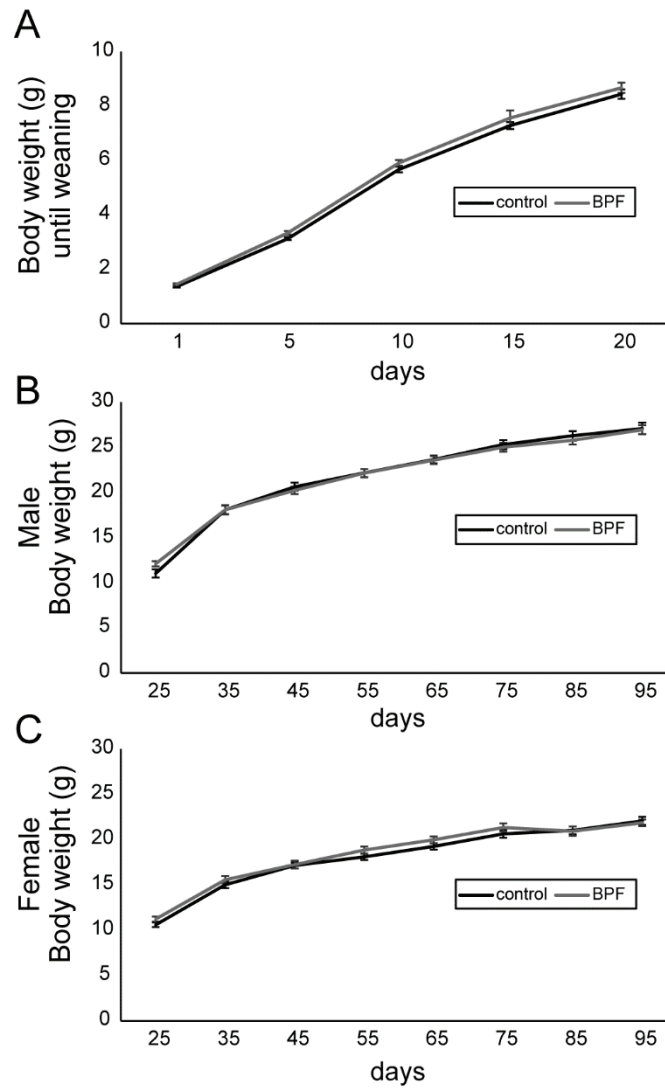
Supplemental Figure 1. Effects of BPA or BPF exposure in late pregnancy on anxiety-like behavior of offspring in the OFT.
