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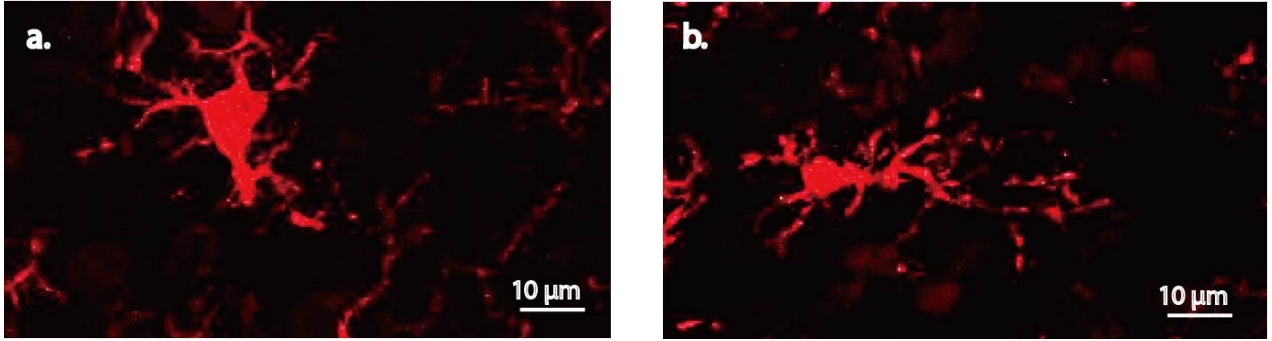


Figure S1. IBA1-immunohistochemistry revealing microglial cells with amoeboid (a, activated) and ramified (b, non-activated) morphology.

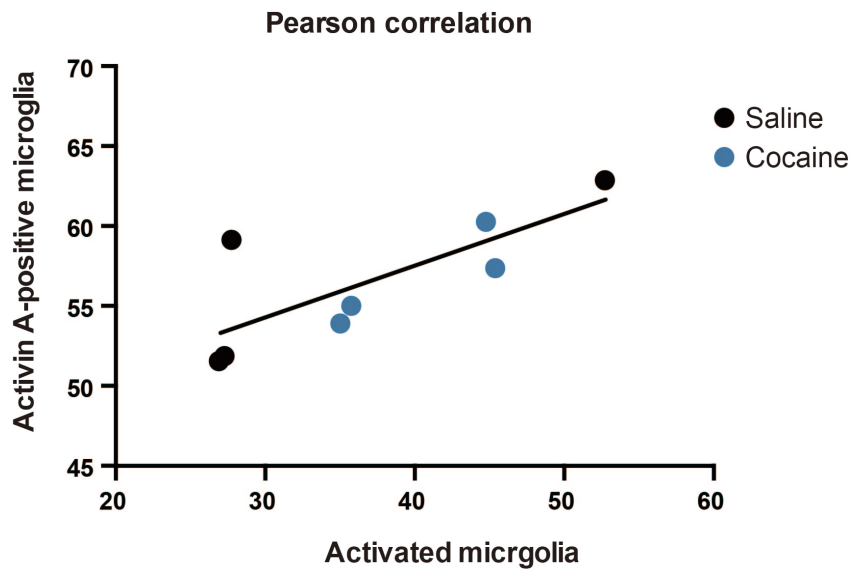


Figure S2. Correlation between activated microglia and activin A⁺ microglia.

Pearson correlation revealed that there is a significant positive correlation between activated microglia number and activin A⁺ microglia number ($r = 0.767$, $P = 0.026$).
