Table S1. Quantitative verbal interaction items
<i>If you have a spouse or partner, how much time on average do you spend in face-to-face conversations with them each day?</i>
<i>How much time on average do you spend in face-to-face conversations with family members other than your spouse or partner each week?</i>
<i>How much time on average do you spend in face-to-face conversations with close friends each week?</i>
<i>When you go to religious services or church, how much time at each service do you spend in face-to-face conversations with other people?^a</i>
<i>When you go to a meeting of a club, lodge, or parent group, how much time at each meeting do you spend in face-to-face interactions with other people?^b</i>
<i>How much time on average do you spend in face-to-face conversations with colleagues each day that you work?</i>
<i>How much time on average do you spend in face-to-face conversations with strangers or people you don't know very well each week (e.g., doctors, waitresses, store clerks, etc.)?</i>
