This paper is in reasonably good shape and the data will be useful for comparison to temperate Tigriopus. My only remaining comment is that the coverage of the CEGMA is relatively low and I don't know how that impacts the estimates of turnover in gene families (which the authors estimate to be quite high). Could this be a result of the fact that the assembly is missing a sizable proportion of core eukaryotic genes?

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
