<sup>a)</sup>In case of an abnormality on UGI, endoscopy is recommended, and a biopsy is performed when an abnormality is found during endoscopy, <sup>b)</sup>Patients at high risk for liver cancer include those with chronic hepatitis determined by serological evidence of infection with hepatitis B or C virus or liver cirrhosis, <sup>c)</sup>In case of an abnormality on FOBT, colonoscopy or a double-contrast barium enema is recommended, and a biopsy is performed when an abnormality is found during colonoscopy.
