CRASH 3 Efficacy Trial (Clinical Randomisation of an Antifibrinolytic in Significant Head Injury)

The finance of £433,276 is subject to the following:-

- Receipt and approval of your final budget with calendarisation of expenditure.
- Finance is expected to be disbursed in two to four instalments. Please provide detailed progress milestones to be reached for each instalment and dates when payments should be made.
- Funds will only be payable on receipt of an invoice to The Moulton Charitable Foundation together with a progress report confirming that the relevant milestones have been met for that instalment.
- Progress reports are required every quarter (i.e. 31st March, 30th June, 30th September & 31st December each year). Again, no payments will be made if quarterly reports are overdue.

- At completion of the trial a presentation of the results will be made (probably in London) to the Trustees.

Subject to the above all being finalized, funding is rapidly available.
