## NICE 2010 COPD Referral Criteria

1.2.5.4 The need for oxygen therapy should be assessed in:

·all patients with very severe airflow obstruction (FEV1 < 30% predicted)</li>
·patients with cyanosis
·patients with polycythaemia
·patients with peripheral oedema
·patients with a raised jugular venous pressure
·patients with oxygen saturations ≤ 92% breathing air.

Assessment should also be considered in patients with severe airflow obstruction (FEV1 30–49% predicted). [2004]
