

Fig. S3. No significant accumulation of basophils at the  $1^{st}$  tick-feeding site in  $Rag2^{-/-}$  mice into which CD4<sup>+</sup> T cells from WT mice were adoptively transferred

CD4<sup>+</sup> T cells from WT mice were adoptively transferred to  $Rag2^{-/-}$  mice as shown in Fig. 2C. Recipient mice were infested once or twice with ticks, and the number of basophils at tick-feeding site was examined on day 2 of infestation (mean  $\pm$  SEM, n=4 each). Data shown are representative of 2 independent experiments. \*P<0.05.
