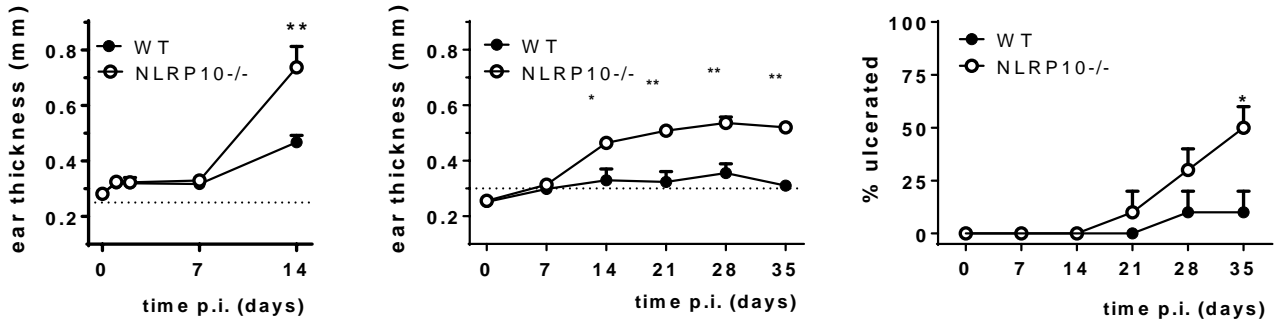
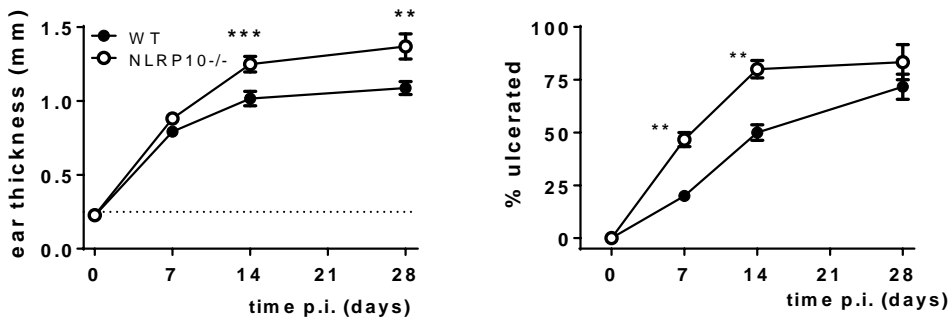

Supplemental figure 1: Enlarged lesions are observed in NLRP10^{-/-} mice on either a C57BL/6 or BALB/c background during infection with Friedlin strain *L. major*. Mice were inoculated with 5×10^5 WT *L. major* Friedlin strain metacyclic promastigotes intradermally in the ear pinna. Shown are the lesion size and proportion of mice with ulcerated lesions. Data in panel A were derived from both short- and long-term infection experiments, shown in different panels. A) WT or NLRP10^{-/-} mice on a C57BL/6 background. B) WT or NLRP10^{-/-} mice on a BALB/c background. Data show results (mean \pm standard error) of $n = 3$ separate experiments, each performed with a minimum of five mice per group. Asterisks indicate significance (* $p < .05$; ** $p < .01$, *** $p < 0.001$).
