

Supplementary figure 1 | Transoesophageal echocardiography in a patient with dynamic mitral regurgitation. The patient was hypotensive, with moderate mitral regurgitation shown with $\bf a$ | colour Doppler imaging and $\bf b$ | continuous-wave Doppler imaging. With volume and pressor loading, the patient developed free mitral regurgitation, with $\bf c$ | lack of mitral leaflet coaptation and $\bf d$ | a dense, dagger-shaped continuous-wave Doppler signal, with a fall in the pressure difference between the left ventricle and left atrium, confirming the dynamic nature of the regurgitation.

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
