

Supplementary Table 2. Standardized List of Complications

Neurologic

New Onset Seizure

New Cerebrovascular Accident (with confirmed imaging)

Cardiovascular

Cardiac Arrhythmia (new onset atrial fibrillation, supraventricular tachycardia, ventricular tachycardia/fibrillation)

Myocardial Infarction (with confirmed elevated troponin)

Cardiogenic Shock (requiring vasopressor treatment)

Respiratory

Acute respiratory failure (requiring intubation and mechanical ventilation > 48 hours)

Gastrointestinal

Ileus

Acute Abdomen (unrelated to trauma)

Renal

Acute renal failure (elevated creatinine ≥ 1.5 without prior history of chronic kidney disease)

Hematologic

Deep Venous Thrombosis (with confirmed ultrasound imaging)

Pulmonary Embolism (with confirmed CT imaging)

Infectious

Pneumonia

Urinary Tract Infection (with positive culture)

Wound Infection

Bacteremia (with positive cultures)

Septic Shock (requiring vasopressor support)
