

Fig. S1 mtDNA levels among patients of similar CSF cell counts.

CSF cell counts and protein levels were not significantly different between NMOSD patients (n=6) and controls (total n=4: aseptic meningitis, n=2; GBS, n=1; neuropsychiatric systemic lupus erythematosus, n=1) (cell counts (mean $\pm$ SEM): NMOSD, 33.8 $\pm$ 6.9 /mm³; Control, 25.0 $\pm$ 7.4 /mm³) (protein (mean $\pm$ SEM): NMOSD, 53.3 $\pm$ 6.0 mg/dl; Control, 72.2 $\pm$ 17.8 mg/dl) (a). mtDNA levels in CSF were significantly higher in patients with NMOSD than in controls (b-d). Total amount of DNA was not significantly different between the two groups (e). \*P<0.05; NS, not significant (P $\geq$ 0.05).
