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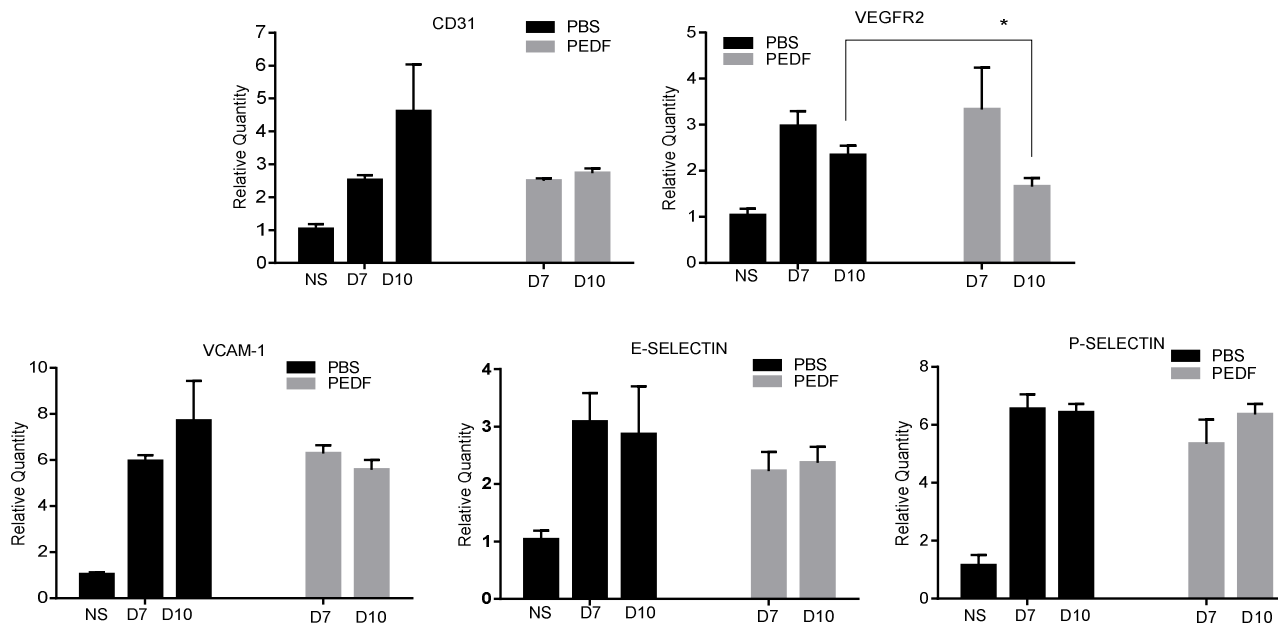

**Suppl. Figure 1.** PEDF regulation of the expression of endothelial cell markers and receptors in skin wounds. Three mm excisional wounds were treated with PEDF topically. mRNA expression of CD31, VEGFR2, VCAM-1, E-Selectin, and P-Selectin in wounds of days 7 and 10 was examined by semi-quantitative real time PCR. The average value for normal skin was set at 1. Mean±SEM; n=5. \*p<0.05, Student's t-tests was used for statistical analysis.
