Web Appendix

In order to examine the utility of the Danish diesel exhaust (DE) job-exposure matrix (NOCCA-DANJEM, constructed by investigators in the Nordic Occupational Cancer Study), we conducted an analysis of DE exposure and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) (defined by ICD-8 code 348.0 or ICD-10 code G12.2) by applying the JEM to a 1:4 age- and sex-matched analysis of COPD cases and controls among the ALS controls in our data. Results for associations between DE exposure and COPD were similar to previously reported associations, producing statistically significant increases in odds of COPD: adjusted odds ratio (aOR) = 1.12 (95% confidence interval (CI): 1.05, 1.19) for the lowest quartile of diesel exhaust exposure and aOR = 1.10 (95% CI: 1.03, 1.17) for the highest quartile of diesel exhaust exposure compared to no exposure (not displayed).
