Survival of N2 L4 larvae exposed to *S. oralis* (VGS#3), *S. oralis* (VGS#4), *S. mitis* (VGS#10), *S. mitis* (VGS#13) and *E. coli* OP50 on THY plates. The data are representative of experiments repeated two or more times with an n = 60 – 90 worms for each condition. Kaplan-Meier log rank analysis was used to compare survival curves and to calculate the median survival. P-values <0.05 were considered to be statistically significant.
