^aThe violence victimization questionnaire was not sent to participants who had previously requested short form surveys or who required more than four mailings before responding to the 1999 questionnaire. Due to potential safety concerns regarding mailing the questions, the IRB allowed only a single reminder postcard for those who were sent the questionnaire but did not immediately respond. The 'did not complete' group includes those who were not sent the questionnaire and those who were sent the questionnaire but did not return it.
