



Supplementary Figure 4: Visual acuity

For each of the 12 participants, a continuous blue line indicates the visual acuity of the study eye, and a dotted orange line indicates that of the contralateral control eye. Baseline visual acuity is presented as the mean of 3 separate measurements. The grey areas indicate test-retest variability, determined using multiple baseline measurements with the one-way ANOVA method.¹
