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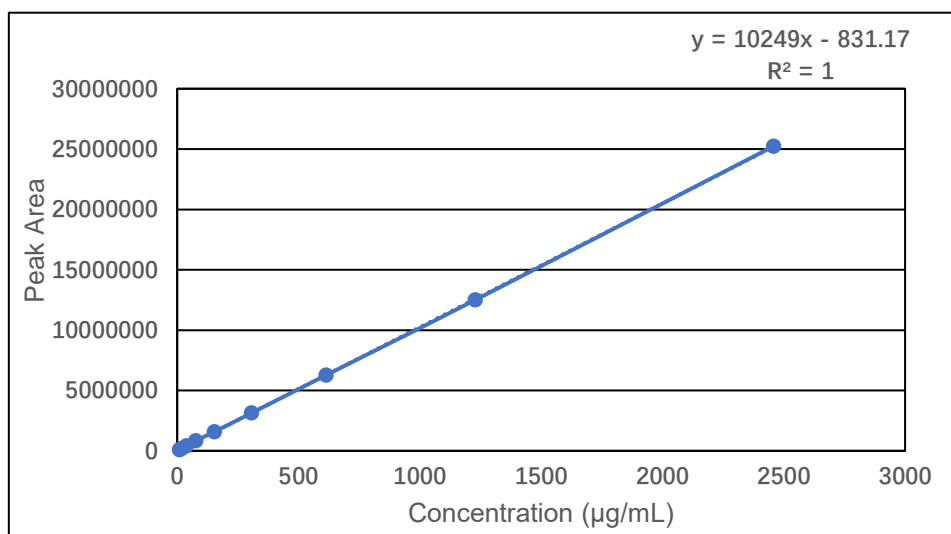
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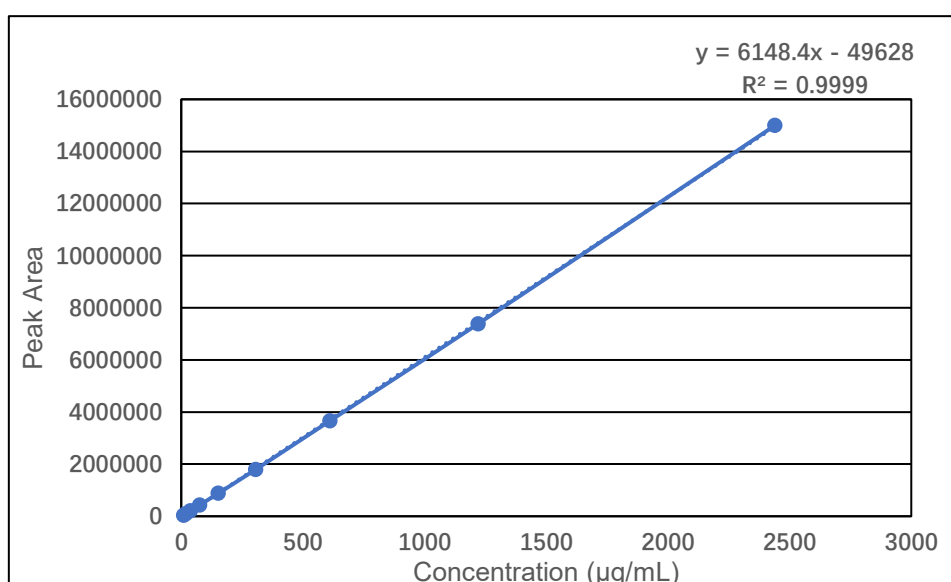
## Linearity calibration of SG-PTX and DG-PTX

Concentrations of SG-PTX and DG-PTX in samples were calculated by calibration curve. For calibration curve, nine concentrations (9.66, 19.32, 38.41, 76.81, 153.63, 307.25, 614.5, 1229 and 2458 µg/mL of SG-PTX, 9.53, 19.06, 38.12, 76.25, 152.5, 305.5, 611.1, 1220 and 2440 µg/mL of DG-PTX) of calibration standards were processed, typical linear regression equations for the calibration curves over concentration ranges for SG-PTX and DG-PTX were shown in Figure S1 and Figure S2.

**Figure S2.** Linearity calibration of DG-PTX.

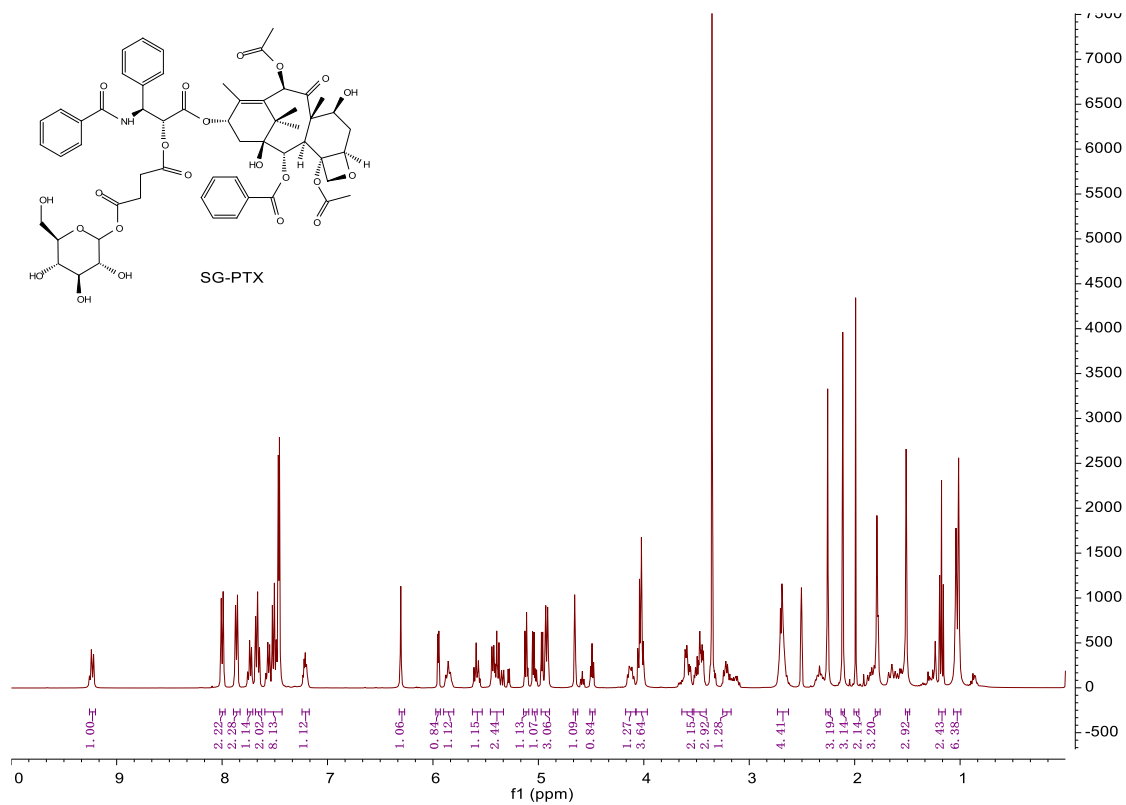


Figure S3.  $^1\text{H}$  NMR spectra of SG-PTX.

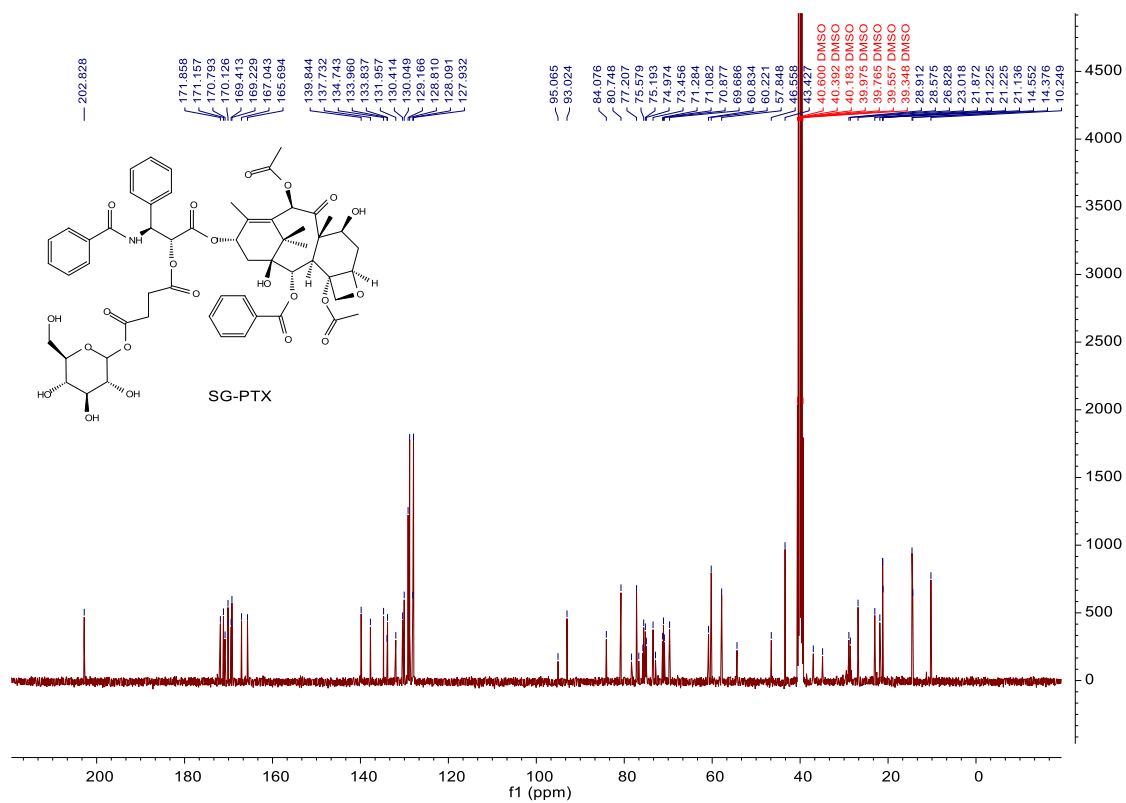


Figure S4.  $^{13}\text{C}$  NMR spectra of SG-PTX.

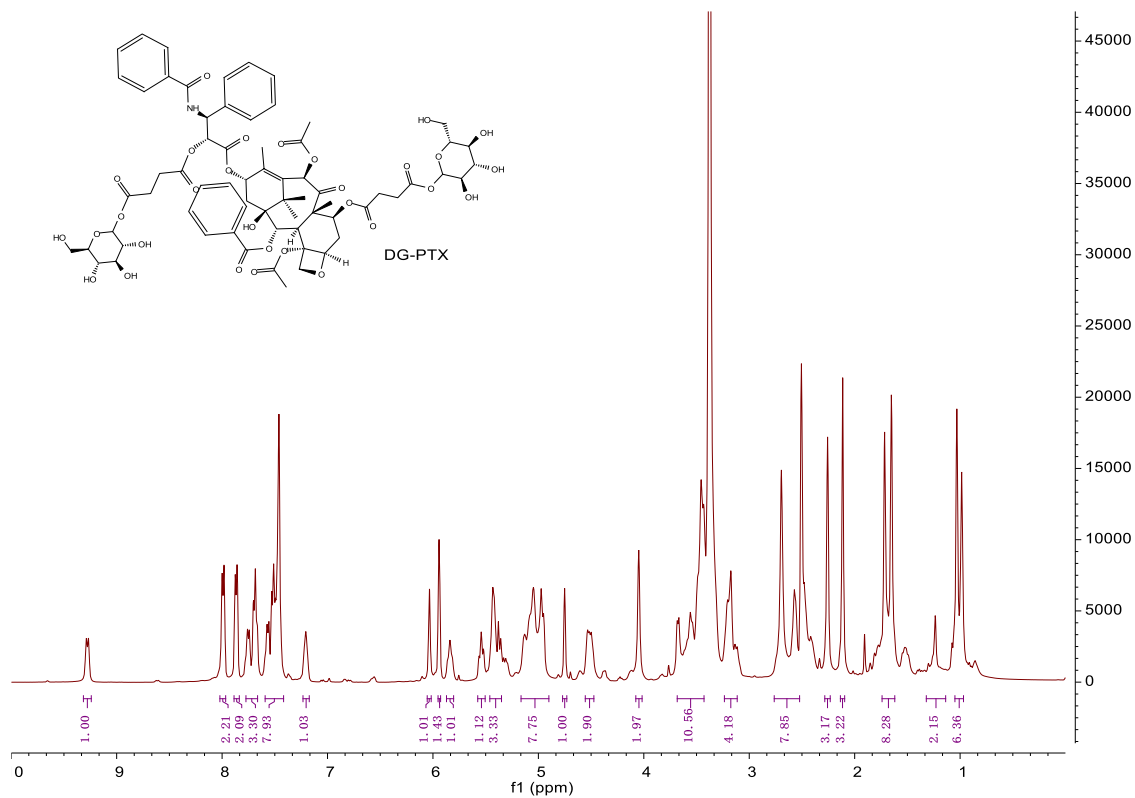


Figure S5.  $^1\text{H}$  NMR spectra of DG-PTX.

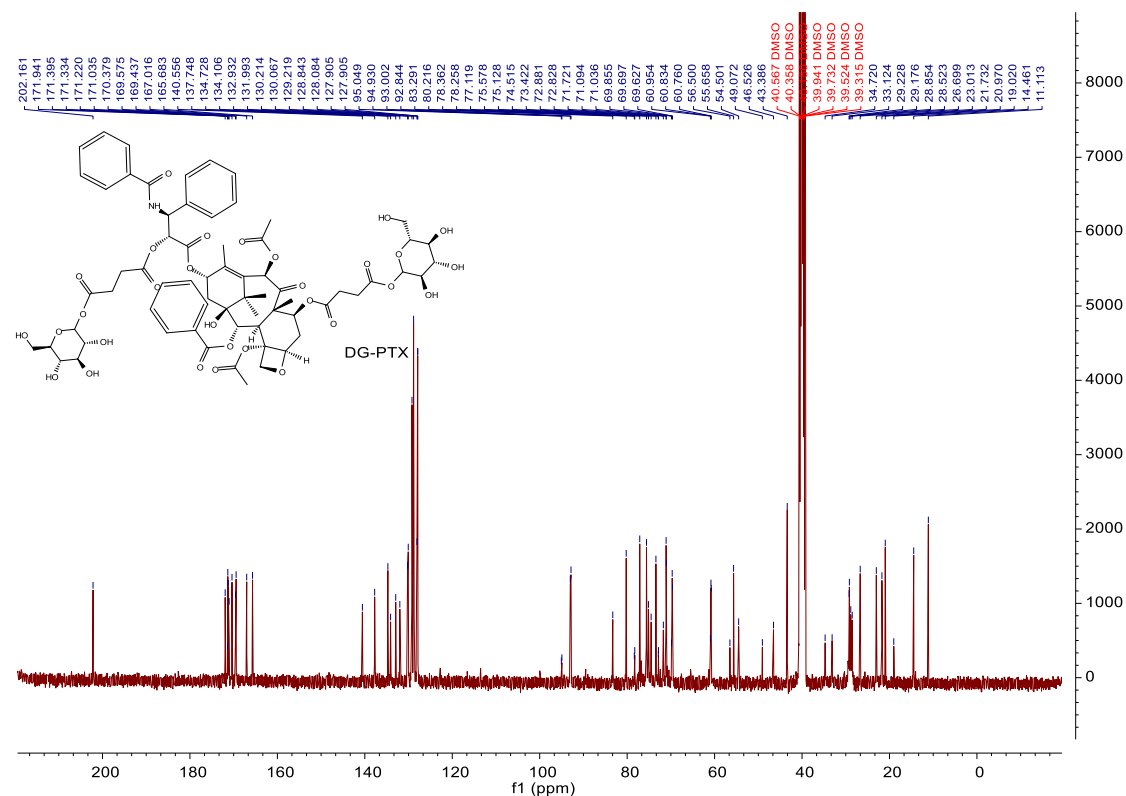


Figure S6.  $^{13}\text{C}$  NMR spectra of DG-PTX.
