SUPPLEMENT 2

Supportive care medicines prescribed at the lung cancer clinic of Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh

Mandatory supportive care medicines after each cycle of chemotherapy:

- Tablet dexamethasone 4 mg one tablet three times a day for 3 days
- Tablet esomeprazole 40 mg OD an hour before breakfast for 5 days

Hematinics:

- Tablet folic acid 0.5 mg along with elemental iron 100 mg once/twice a day
- Tablet Vitamin B, 10 mg with vitamin B, 3mg OD
- Tablet ferrous sulfate 200 mg BD (for pemetrexed)
- Syrup containing folic acid 200 mcg, Vitamin B12 5 mcg, Nicotinamide 20 mg/5 ml 5 ml OD (for pemetrexed)

Symptom-based supportive medications taken as and when needed:

- Epigastric burning or pain Tablet esomeprazole 40 mg
- Vomiting/nausea
 - Tablet aprepitant 125 mg on day 1 and 80 mg on days 2 and 3. Tablet granisetron 1 mg (max 2 times/day)
 - Tablet prochlorperazine 10 mg (max 3 times/day)
- Constipation
 - Isabgol husk 3–4 tablespoon HS with water or milk
 - Tablet bisacodyl 5 mg HS
 - Syrup lactulose 3–4 tsp
- Diarrhea
 - Tablet loperamide 2 mg two tablets stat and once every 3-4 h
 - Tablet ciprofloxacin 500 mg + tinidazole 600 mg BD \times 5 days (if diarrhea is associated with fever or blood/mucus in stool)
- Dry cough and/or streaky hemoptysis
 - Syrup levocloperastine 20 mg/5 ml 1 teaspoon (maximum thrice a day)
 - Syrup codeine 10 mg/5 ml 2 teaspoons (maximum three-four times a day)
- Mouth ulcers Multivitamin 1 OD \times 10 days
- Fever Tablet paracetamol 500 mg (maximum four times a day)
- Pain
 - Tablet tramadol 37.5 + paracetamol 325 mg (max two times a day)
 - Tablet diclofenac 50–100 mg (max two times a day)
 - Tablet codeine 30 mg + paracetamol 650 mg 1 tablet (max three times a day)
