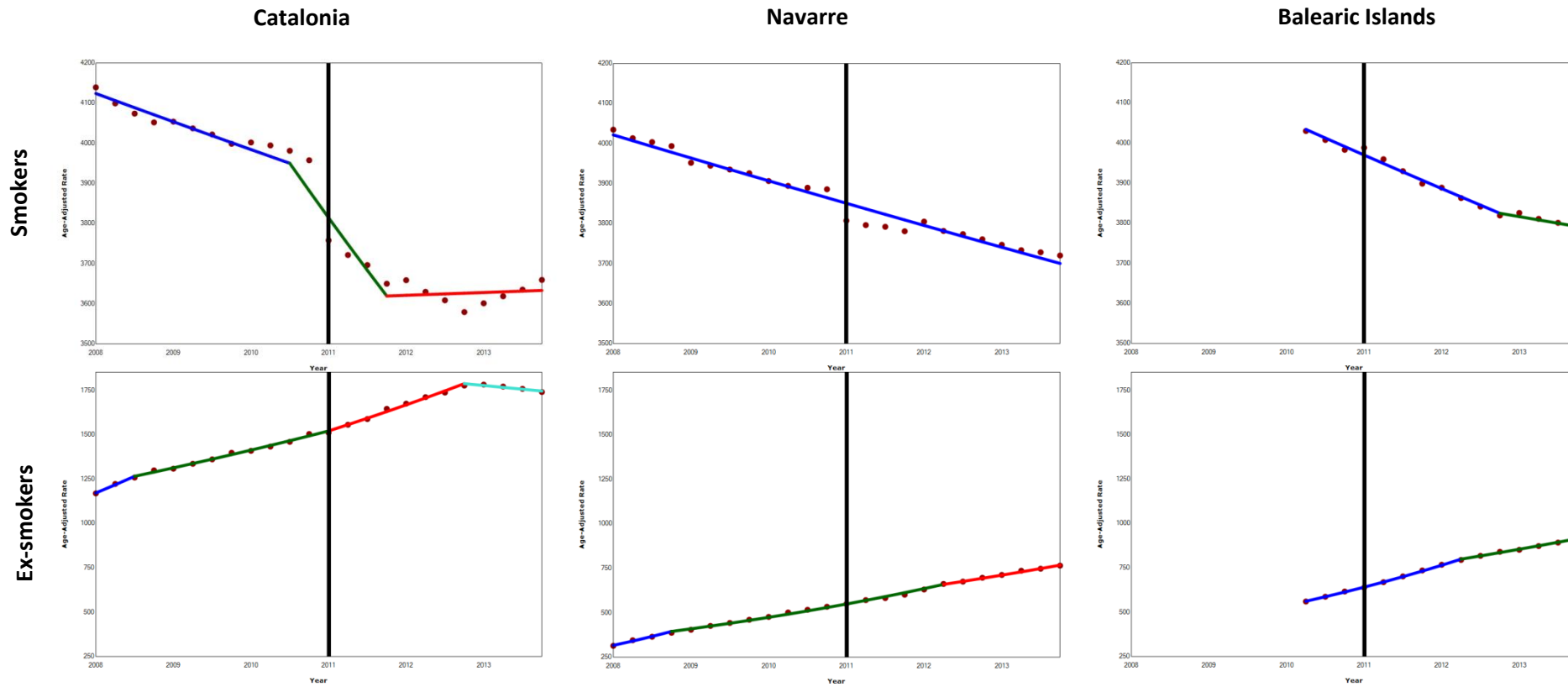


Figure S1: Overall trends of age-standardized prevalence rates of smoking status in Catalonia, Navarre and the Balearic Islands.

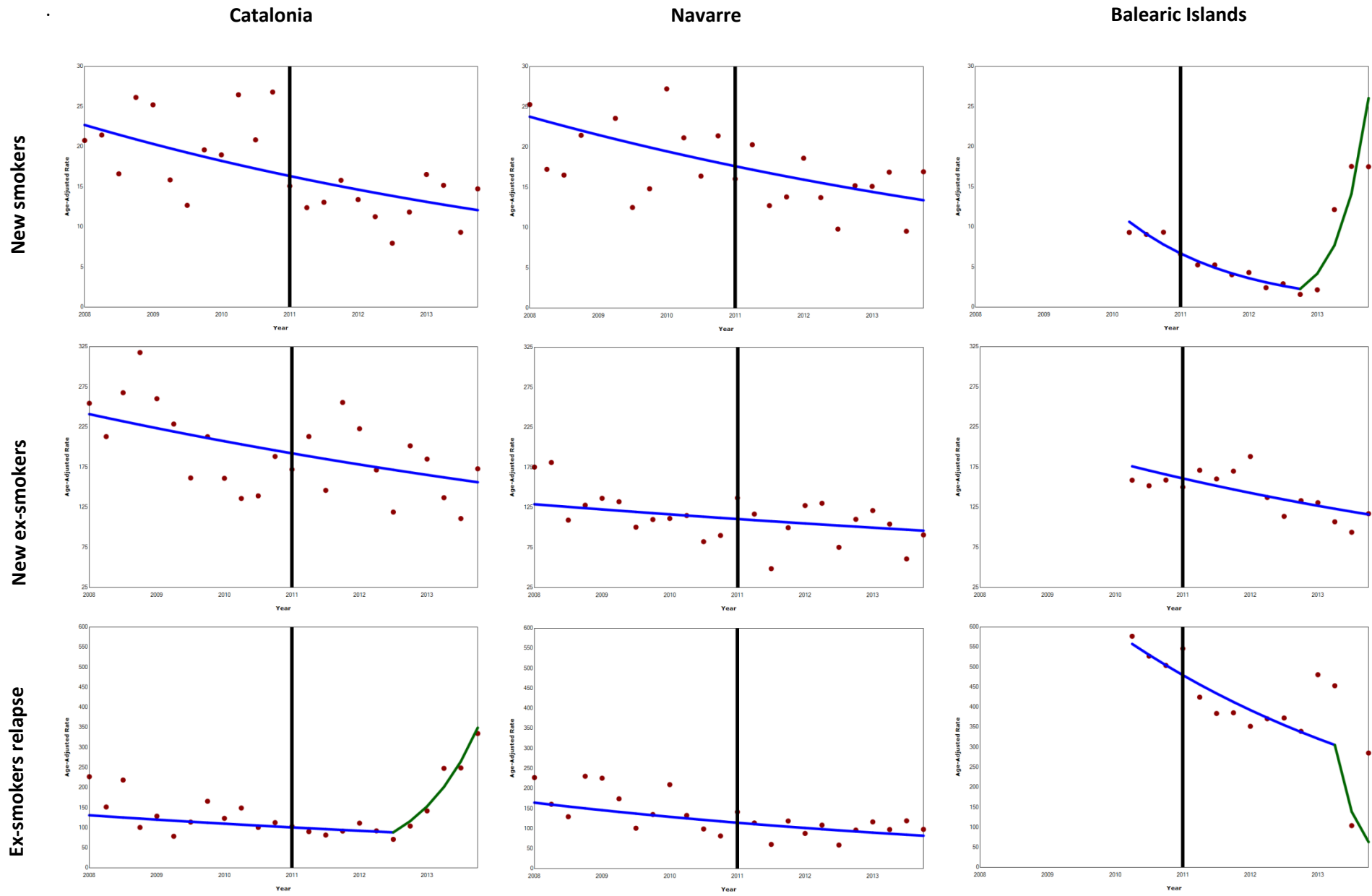
