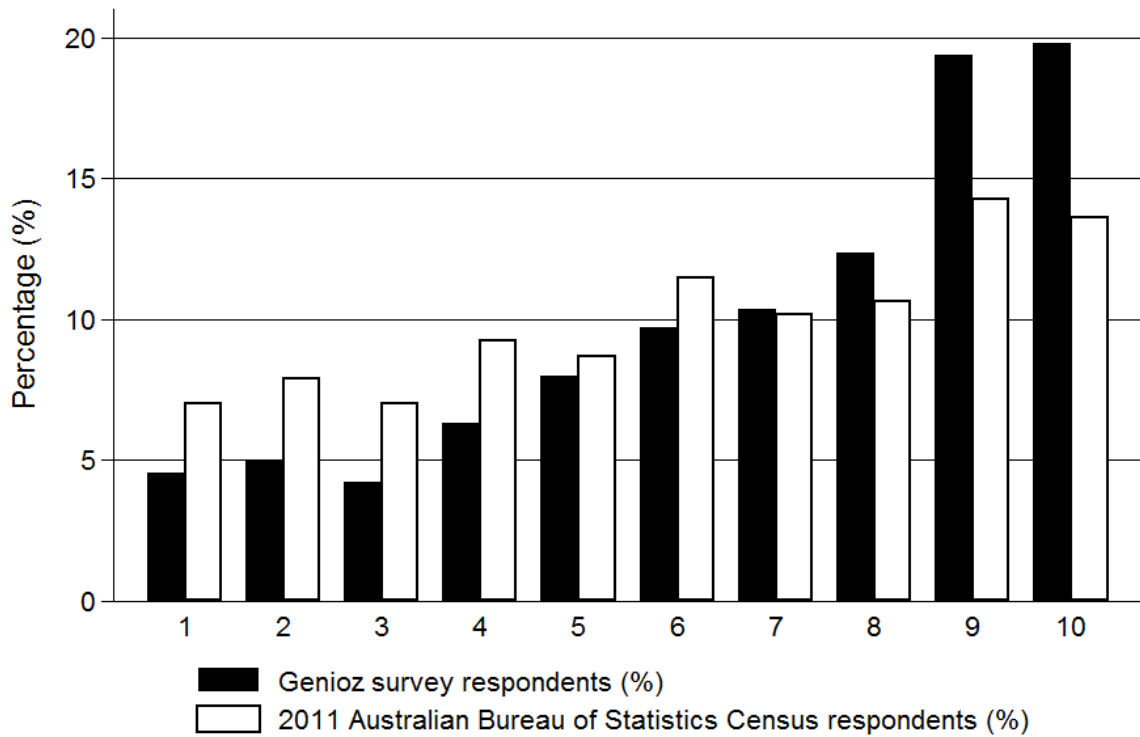

<sup>a</sup> SEIFA (IRSAD) – Socio-Economic Indexes for Areas (Index of Relative Socio-Economic Advantage and Disadvantage) – ranks areas in Australia according to relative socio-economic advantage and disadvantage. These indices are based on information from the five-yearly census. For brevity, the deciles as displayed above from the ABS have been collapsed to quintiles, as reported in Table 1.
