Externalizing (10 items)

Angry and resentful
Gets back at people
Argues a lot with adults
Gets in many fights
Has been physically cruel to others
Cruelty, bullying or meanness to others
Destroys things belonging to their family or other children
Loses temper
Easily annoyed by others
Runs away from home

Attention problems (6 items)

Can't concentrate, can't pay attention for long
Can't stay seated when required to do so
Impulsive or acts without thinking
Distractible, has trouble sticking to any activity
Fails to finish things they start
Fidgets
