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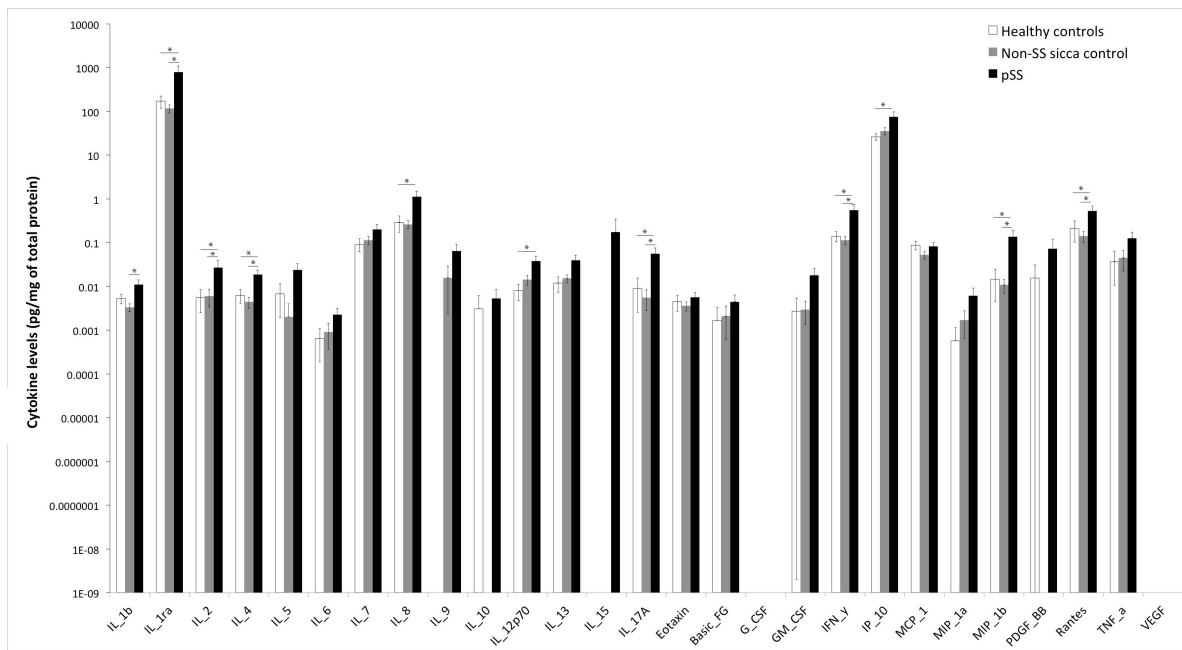


Figure S1. Comparison of tear cytokine levels adjusted by total protein. Intergroup difference is considered significant at  $*p < 0.05$ .

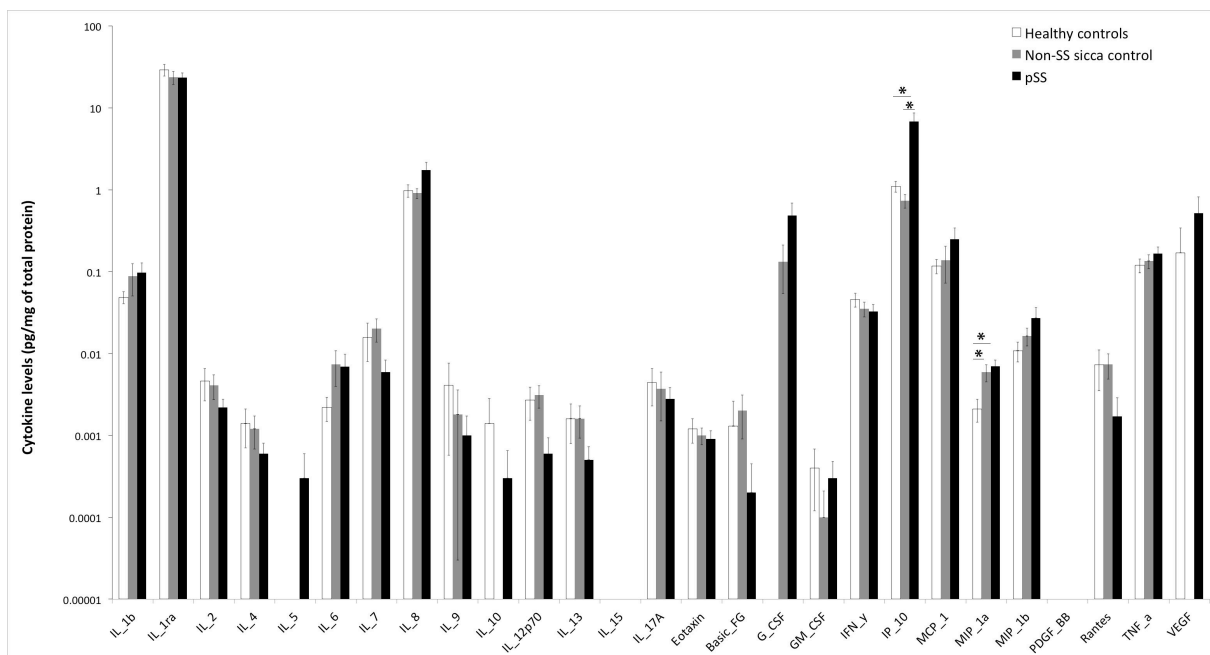


Figure S2. Comparison of salivary cytokine levels adjusted by total protein. Intergroup difference is considered significant at  $*p < 0.05$ .
