## Pain Management Postoperative Discharge Prescribing Guidelines Breast Combined Cases – Mastectomy with Subcutaneous Breast Reconstruction

## Subcutaneous breast reconstruction

- 1) Average Pain Patients and all patients over age 65 years
  - Schedule acetaminophen 1 Gram every 6 hours x 2 weeks
  - Ultram 50 or 100 mg every 6 hours prn pain not relieved by acetaminophen #20
     \*Consider age and creatinine clearance when deciding 50 or 100 mg
  - Oxycodone 5 mg every 4 hours prn pain not controlled by acetaminophen and tramadol - #15
- 2) Risk for High Pain Patients (Pain > 7 (frequently); taking oxycodone six or more tablets during hospital stay; <age 65y)
  - Schedule acetaminophen 1 Gram every 6 hours x 2 weeks
  - Schedule Ultram 50 mg or 100 mg every 6 hours x 2 weeks #30
     \*Consider age and creatinine clearance when deciding 50 or 100 mg
  - Oxycodone 5 mg 1-2 tablets every 4 hours prn pain not relieved by acetaminophen and tramadol - #30
- 3) Chronic Pain Provider Discretion (> 12 weeks)
