Clinic Flow Protocol for Fluoride Varnish

Age: 6 months- 3 years

Visit: Well Child visit

Frequency: every 3-6 months

Clinic Flow

Clinic front desk identifies the correct age for the well child visits

6 months – 3 years of age

Medical Assistants or nurses administer the oral health questionnaire to the patient, collects, and document them in the chart.

Health care providers review the oral health questionnaire, discuss good practices and if no dental home is identified, recommends oral fluoride varnish

If patient family consents, the physician directs the clinic staff for administration of the fluoride varnish to the child.

If a dental home is identified or no teeth yet, it is documented in the charts.
